God's Story: Luke 7:36-50

- 1. **Weep**
 - Example of a soft heart toward sin and conviction of the Holy Spirit.
 - Isaiah 6:5 "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty."

2. Worship

- A lifestyle of worship. On our knees before the Savior.
- "Our thoughts change brain chemistry. We google and gossip our brain cells get sick... Holy thoughts heal us! It's in the science. With thoughts of worship, our brain cells gain health...worship can change our mental health. When we choose to worship Christ our brain and our body follow." -Dr. Caroline Leaf

3. Wash

- In her washing of our Lord's feet, our Lord washed her of her sin. We're washed of our sins. This compels us to wash the feet of others.
- "While we have time, let us do good to every person, especially to the members of the household of faith." Galatians 6: 10
