- 3) **Mishael** – means “*Who is like God?*”  
- Meshach – “*Who is as Aku is?*”
- 4) **Azariah** – means “*The Lord is my help*”  
- Changed to Abednego – “*Servant of Nebo*”

1. Resolved /determined = literally “set his heart on”

2. Food and wine –

- issue of eating unclean foods (Lev. 11:1-23)

- Food offered to idols (Deut. 6:13-15)

3. Daniel and his friends were forced to be in Babylon,  
but they were resolved to not let Babylon get into them
