*James 2:20-26*

**MAIN IDEA:** True faith is a living faith which expresses itself in works of righteousness. A faith that is working is a faith that is growing.

## III. JAMES & PAUL: TWO ASPECTS OF JUSTIFICATION & RIGHTEOUSNESS

### A. Paul's focus:

- 1. \_\_\_\_\_ Justification - the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Christian's life.
  - a) The moment you truly trust Christ is the moment you are justified before God.
  - b) In Ephesians 2:8-9, Paul wants us to avoid thinking that works are means of our salvation. Salvation is receiving, through faith, Gods free gift of grace.

## B. James' focus:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Justification - the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Christians life
  - a) What happens on Judgement Day, when God declares us right in His sight. (Matthew 25)
  - b) In James 2:24, James wants us to avoid thinking that works are not at all important. Works are the evidence of salvation.

  1. **ESV** - "*You see that faith was active along with his works, and faith was completed by his works*"
  2. **NASB** - "*You see that faith was working with his works, and as a result of the works, faith was perfected*"
  3. James says our works complete/perfect our faith
- C. The \_\_\_\_\_ nature of true faith:
 

*Saving faith = works of righteousness = greater faith = greater works*
- D. True faith is a living faith which expresses itself in works of righteousness. In turn, our works of righteousness builds up, strengthens, and perfects our faith. A true working faith, is a growing faith.
