- 4. What does it mean to strive side by side for the Gospel?
- 5. In verse 28, Paul tells us not to be frightened of our opponents. What are some ways that Christians typically react to opponents of the Gospel?
- 6. Read verses 29-20. What does it mean that it has been granted for us to believe in Christ and to suffer for his sake?
- 7. In verse 30, Paul says we are engaged in this struggle together. What are the dangers of thinking we are alone or that our struggles are unique?
- 8. What obstacles keep us from striving side by side with one spirit and one mind for the sake of the Gospel at FBC Spearman?
- 9. How should the radical message of the Gospel humble us to love our church family better?
