

Day 1: The Supremacy of Christ

Reading: Hebrews 1:1-4

Devotional: As we begin this journey, let's focus on the supremacy of Christ. The author of Hebrews paints a magnificent picture of Jesus as the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being. Today, reflect on what it means that Jesus is superior to all creation. How does this truth impact your daily life? Consider areas where you might be underestimating Jesus or seeking fulfillment elsewhere. Pray for a renewed vision of Christ's supremacy and for the strength to place Him at the center of your life.

Day 2: God's Enduring Love

Reading: Psalm 103:1-22

Devotional: Today's passage reminds us of God's unfailing love and compassion. Just as the sermon emphasized that Jesus loves us now, not some future version of us, meditate on the depth of God's current love for you. How does knowing that God's love is constant, despite your failures, change your approach to life and faith? Take time to praise God for His forgiveness and grace, and consider how you can extend that same love to others around you.

Day 3: Faith in Times of Doubt

Reading: Hebrews 11:1-6

Devotional: The recipients of the letter to the Hebrews were struggling with doubt and the temptation to abandon their faith. Today's reading defines faith and provides examples of those who held firm. Reflect on your own journey of faith. What challenges or doubts are you facing? Remember that faith is not the absence of doubt, but trusting God despite our uncertainties. Pray for the courage to continue in faith, even when the path seems unclear.

Day 4: The Sufficiency of Christ

Reading: Colossians 2:6-15

Devotional: The sermon emphasized that Jesus is enough. Today's passage reinforces this truth, reminding us that in Christ we have been given fullness. Consider areas in your life where you might be seeking fulfillment outside of Jesus. What would it look like to truly believe that Christ is sufficient for all your needs? Challenge yourself to release one thing you've been clinging to for security or satisfaction, and instead turn to Jesus in full dependence.

Day 5: Hope in Suffering

Reading: Romans 8:18-39

Devotional: Life's challenges can sometimes make us question God's love and presence. Today's powerful passage reminds us that nothing can separate us from God's love in Christ Jesus. As you read, reflect on any current struggles you're facing. How does the promise of God's unwavering love and future glory bring hope to your situation? Take time to bring your burdens before God, trusting in His sovereign care and the ultimate victory we have in Christ.
