“The probability of producing even a single functional protein of modest length (150 amino acids) by chance alone in a prebiotic environment stands at no better than a “vanishingly small” 1 chance in 10 to the 64th, an inconceivably small probability. To put this number in perspective, recall that physicists estimate that there are only 10 to the 80th elementary particles in the entire universe.”
