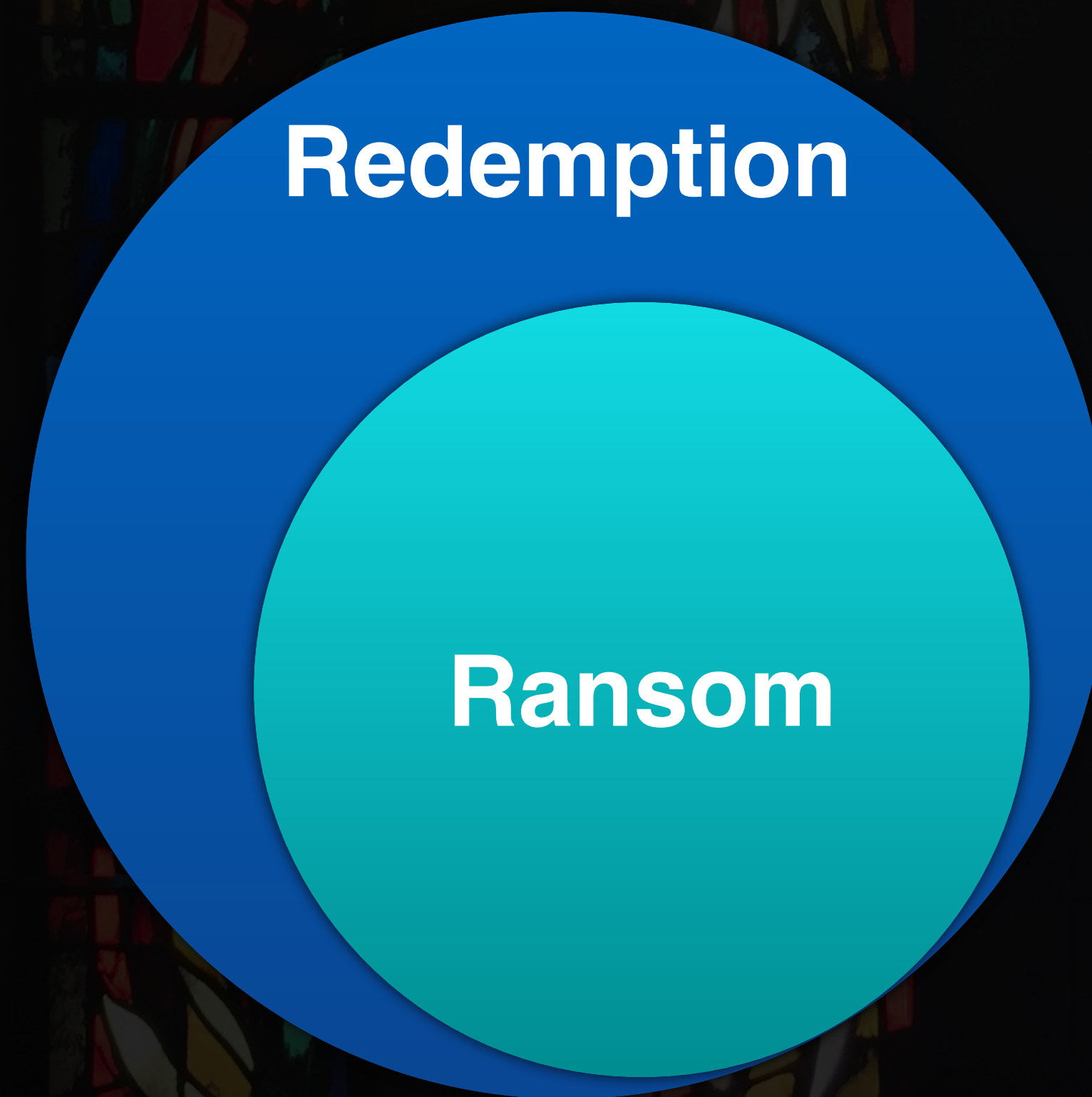
Redemption/Ransom

*Jesus is our **redemption**, he bought us out of slavery to our sin, and he did that by becoming a **ransom** himself.*

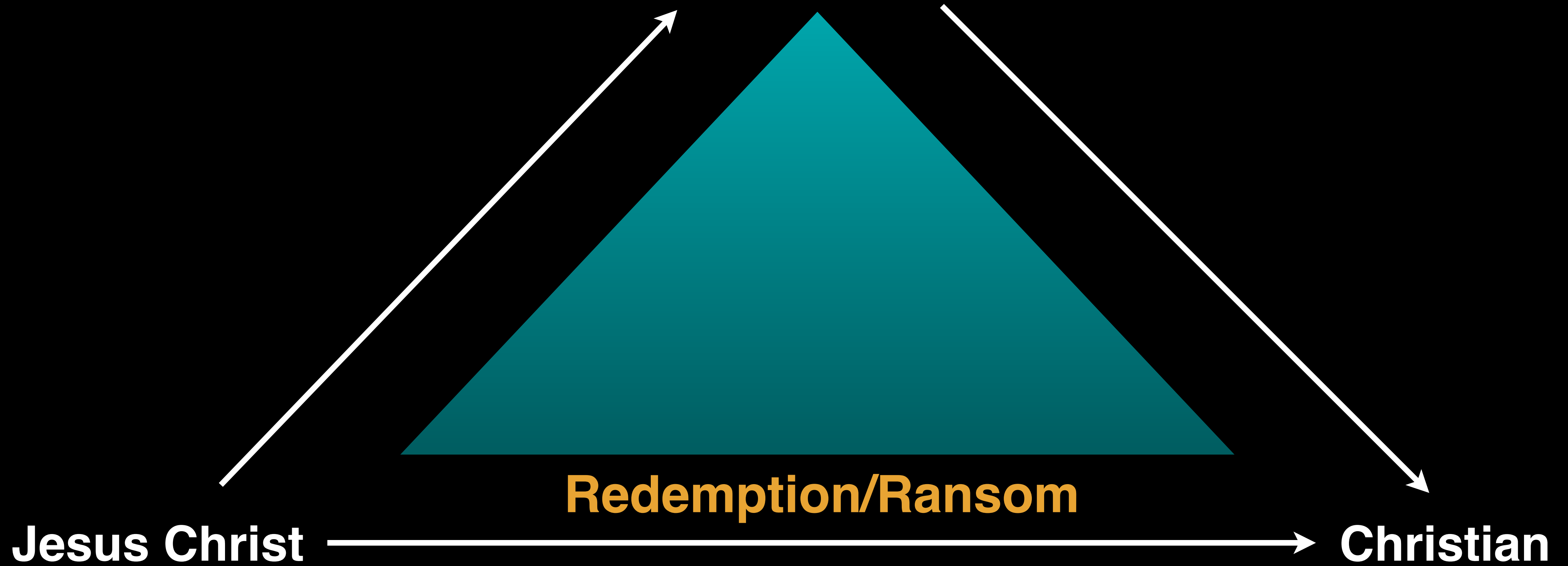

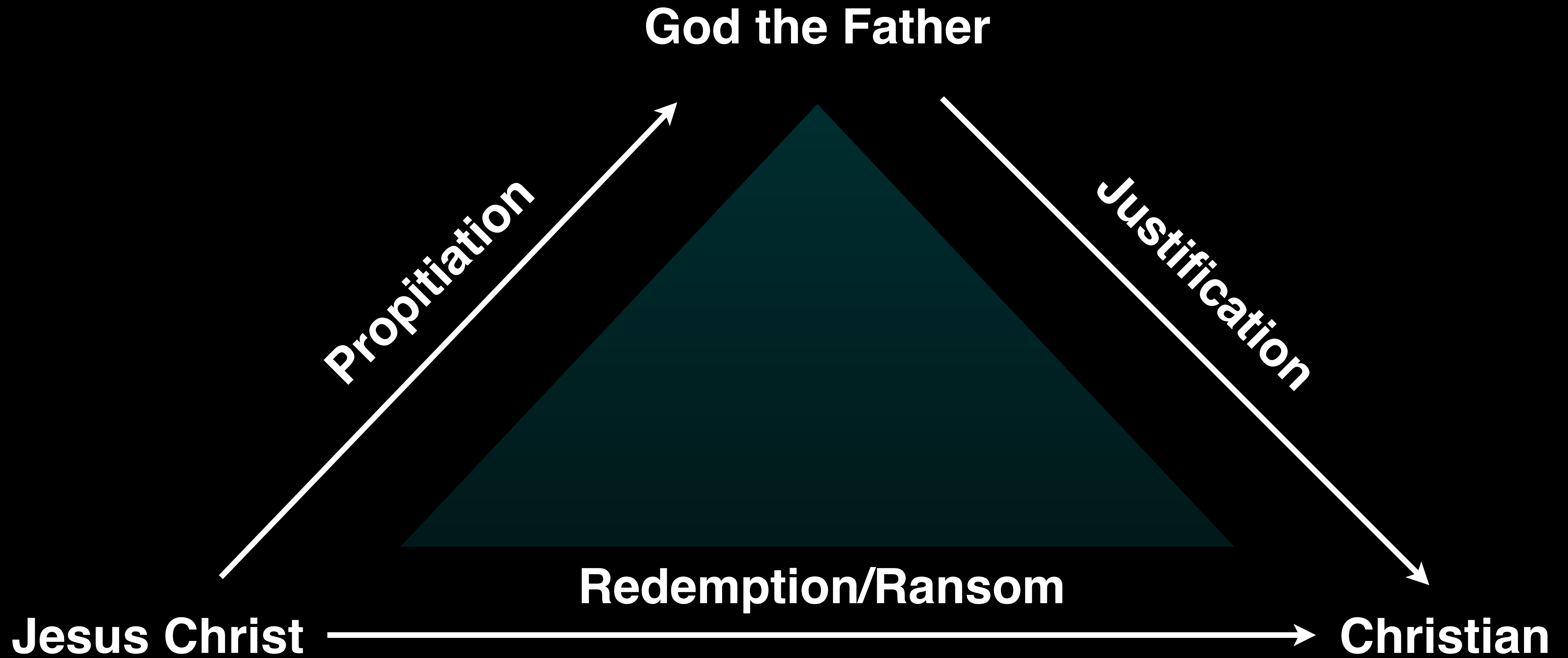


Why Christ Came to Die

“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the **redemption** that came by Christ Jesus. God presented him as a **propitiation** through **faith** in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished—he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have **faith in Jesus.**”
