### Humility:

The freedom from pride or arrogance : the quality or state of being humble." Humble: having or showing a modest or low estimate of one's own importance.



Gentle:

#### Free from harshness, sternness, or violence

#### Patient:

Bearing pains or trials calmly or without complaint; manifesting forbearance under provocation or strain, not hasty or impetuous, steadfast despite opposition, difficulty, or adversity. Ephesians 4:3

#### Bond: To form a close relationship especially through Frequent Association

#### Grace:

Unmerited divine assistance given to humans for their regeneration or sanctification

### Prophets:

The ordinary Hebrew word for prophet is nabi, derived from a verb signifying "to bubble forth" like a fountain; hence the word means one who announces or pours forth the declarations of God.

#### Evangelisk:

An enthusiastic advocate; a "publisher of glad tidings;" a missionary preacher of the gospel

#### Pastor: L. pasco, pastum, to feed.

A shepherd; one that has the care of flocks and herds. A minister of the gospel who has the charge of a church and congregation, whose duty is to watch over the people of his charge, and instruct them in the sacred doctrines of the christian religion.
