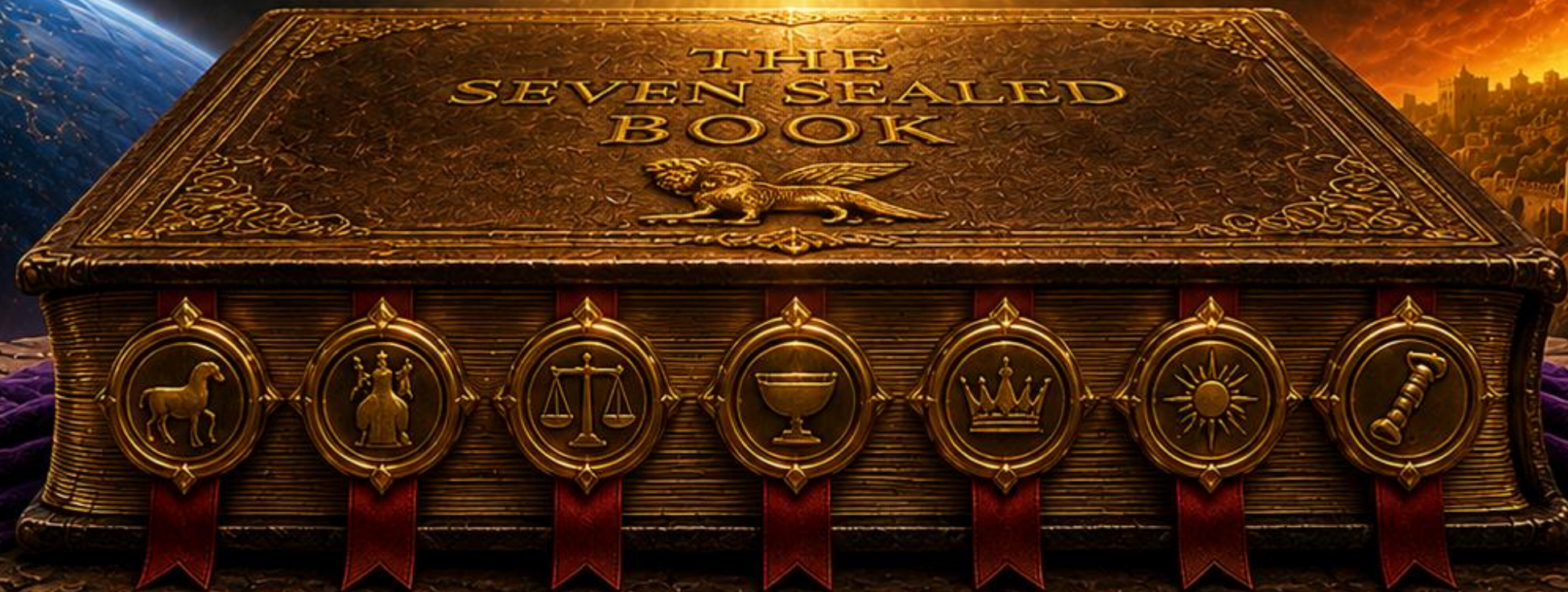


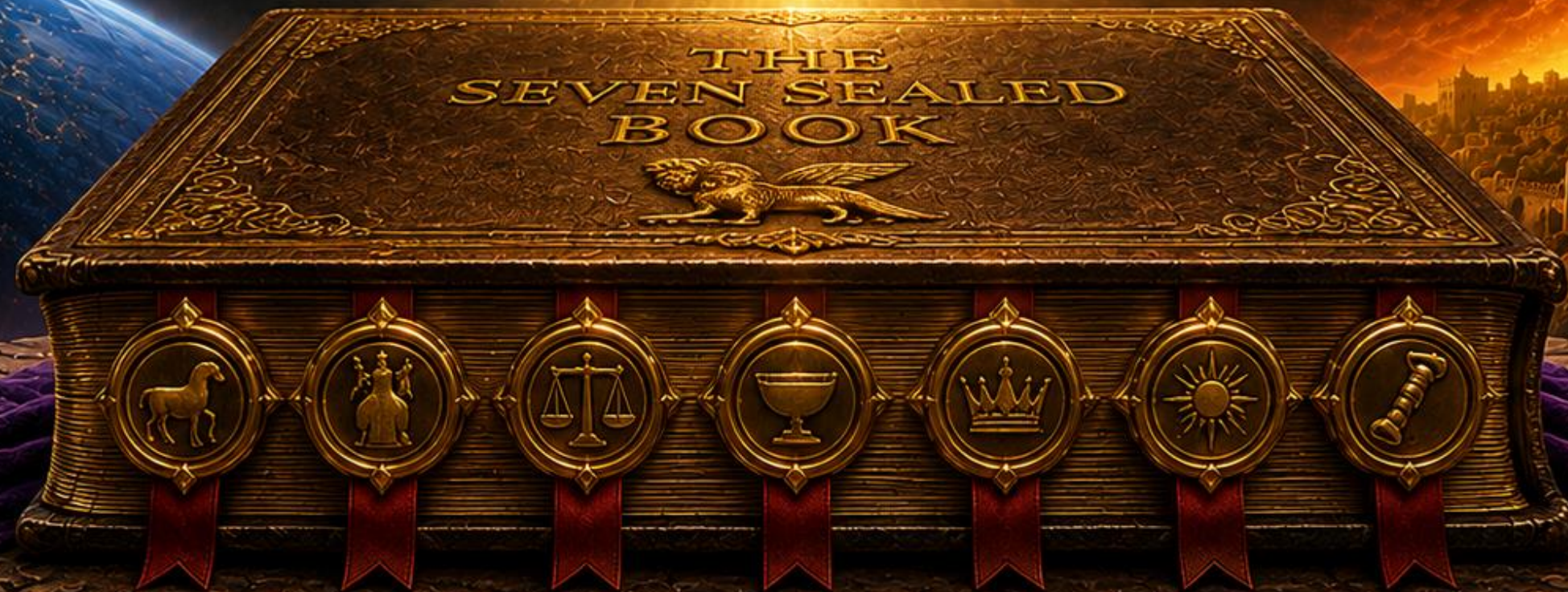

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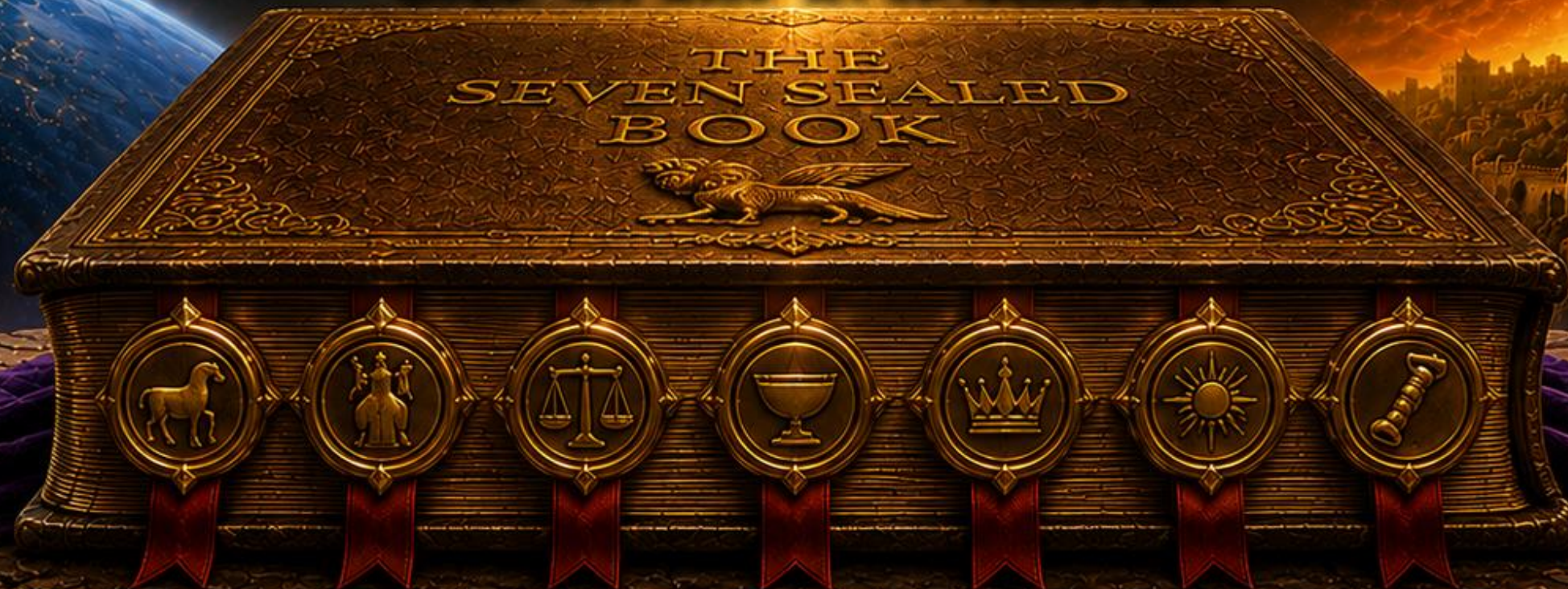

THE SEVEN SEALED BOOK BEING OPENED

“And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.”

FIRST SEAL
WHITE HORSE



He went forth conquering, and to conquer.

Rev. 6:2

SECOND SEAL
RED HORSE



And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another.

THIRD SEAL
BLACK HORSE



And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

FOURTH SEAL
PALE HORSE



And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him.

FIFTH SEAL
MARTYRS' CRY



And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God.

SIXTH SEAL
COSMIC DISTURBANCE



And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake.

SEVENTH SEAL
NOT YET OPENED



But when he shall have opened the seventh seal, there shall be silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.

— in between the 6th and 7th Seals —



FIRST SEAL WHITE HORSE



He went forth conquering, and to conquer.

THIRD SEAL BLACK HORSE

THE TABERNACLE

Exodus 25–31, 35–40

The Tabernacle was the portable dwelling place of God among the Israelites during their journey in the wilderness. It was to be built according to the pattern shown to Moses on the mountain.



50 cubits
(≈75 ft / 23 m)

100 cubits
(≈150 ft / 45 m)

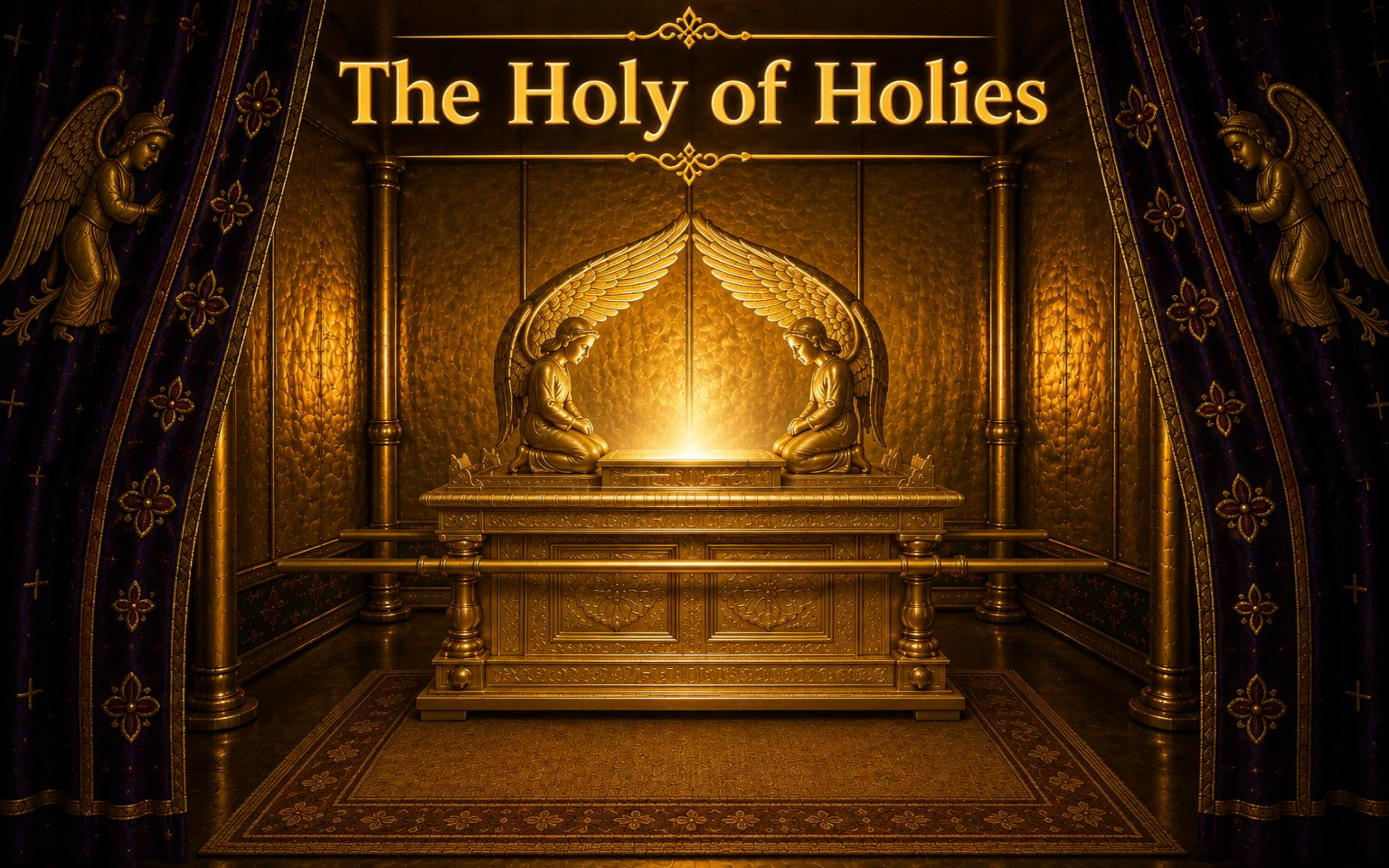
THE COURTYARD

- Surrounded by linen curtains on 20 pillars of bronze (north and south sides)
- 10 pillars on the west side
- 5 pillars on the east side (entrance)
- Dimensions:
100 cubits by 50 cubits
- Inside the courtyard:
 - Altar of Burnt Offering
 - Laver for washing

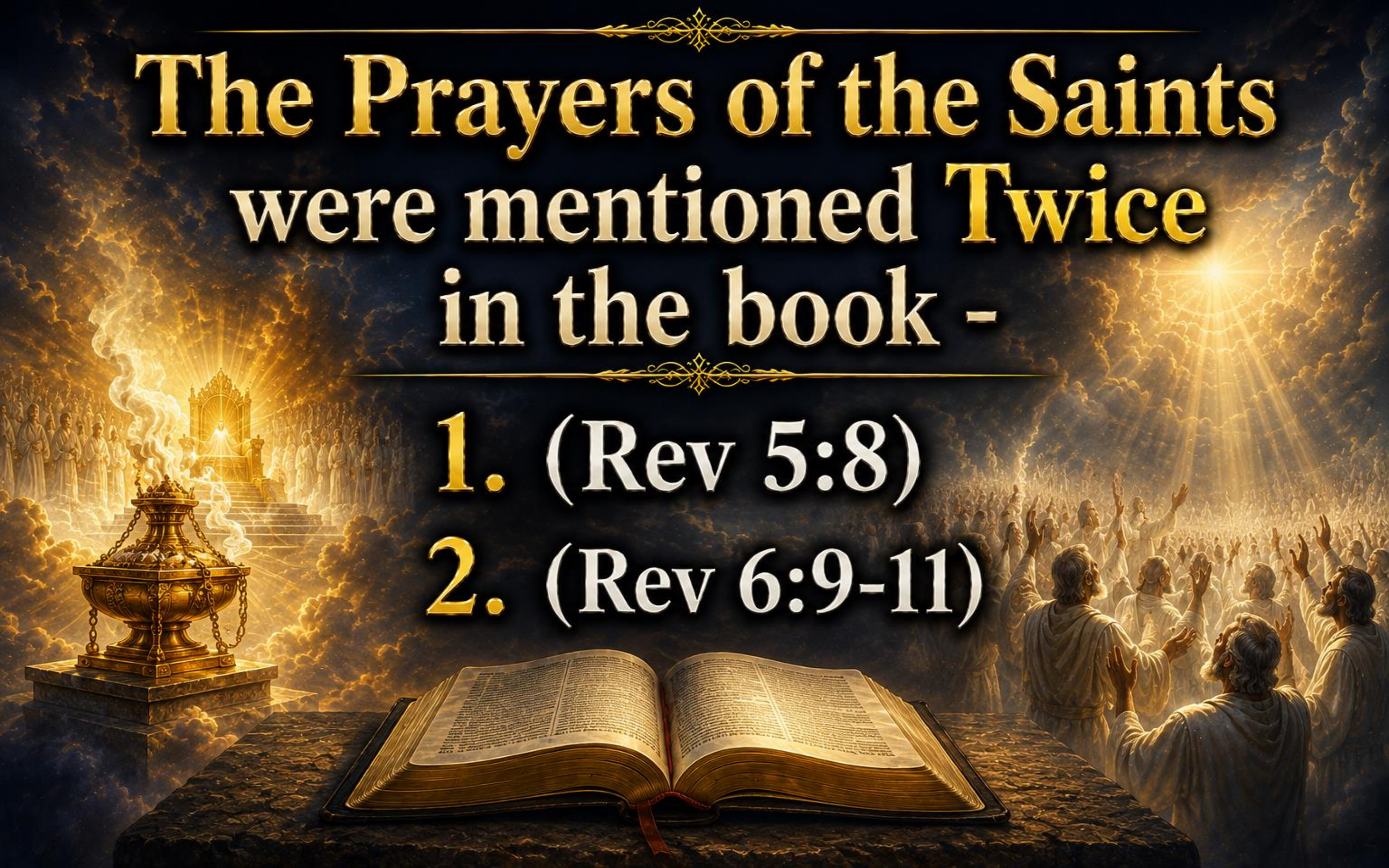

Revelation 8:5-6

⁵ And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: and there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings, and an earthquake.

⁶ And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.



Revelation 8:7

7 And the first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast into the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.



Revelation 8:8-9

- ⁸ And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood;
- ⁹ And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.



Revelation 8:10-11

¹⁰ And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

¹¹ And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.



Revelation 8:12

¹² And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shined not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.



Revelation 8:13

13 And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!



John 3:16-21 (NLT)

- 
- 16** For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.
- 17** God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him.
- 18** There is no judgment against anyone who believes in him. But anyone who does not believe in him has already been judged for not believing in God's one and only Son.
- 19** And the judgment is based on this fact: God's light came into the world, but people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil.
- 20** All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed.
- 21** But those who do what is right come to the light so others can see that they are doing what God wants.
