III. God's Definition of Love

I Corinthians 13:3-10 Message

³⁻⁷ If I give everything I own to the poor and even go to the stake to be burned as a martyr, but I don't love, I've gotten nowhere. So, no matter what I say, what I believe, and what I do, I'm bankrupt without love.

Love never gives up. Love cares more for others than for self. Love doesn't want what it doesn't have. Love doesn't strut. Doesn't have a swelled head. Doesn't force itself on others. Isn't always "me first," Doesn't fly off the handle, Doesn't keep score of the sins of others, Doesn't revel when others grovel, Takes pleasure in the flowering of truth, Puts up with anything, Trusts God always, Always looks for the best, Never looks back. But keeps going to the end. 8-10 Love never dies...

IV. 3 Areas to Focus to Grow in God's Love

- 1. Faith Faith that moves mountains. Now is your time to trust God and believe Him for the impossible. Faith works by love.
- 2. Generosity Generosity is when you give over and above what is required. It includes giving of your time, treasure, and talent. Generosity is about letting people be a part of your life. The reason we give is out of love.
- 3. Discipleship The reason we make disciples is out of love.

V. How Do We Make Disciples?

- 1. Embrace new people. Include new people as much as you can. If you have 10 people around, try to have 2-3 people that are newer to your group.
- 2. Have fun times at your home where you can relax and invite new people as well. Get-togethers like barbeques and game nights are opportunities for relationships and bonds to be formed.
- 3. Ask people out for coffee or lunch. Ask them a simple question. What is the best thing happening in your life? What is the greatest challenge you are facing?
- 4. Set up personal bible studies for those who are willing. If you invite someone new to church, just commit to meeting weekly for a season, helping them with their spiritual questions and getting used to the bible.
- 5. Study on love and ask God to help you use His love to invest in others.
