Walk It Like I Talk It

2 Timothy 1:7 [NIV]

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

In order to overcome fear, we must face the fear. It is not enough to know the Word; we must do it.

I. Our Giant Is Not Defeated with the Same Tools as Others

- 1. Saul's armor was not made for David. God provides us each with our own unique tools to fight our own fight.
- 2. Run to the battle line and know that God will be there to protect you

1 Samuel 17:8-11 [NIV]

⁸Goliath stood and shouted to the ranks of Israel, "Why do you come out and line up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and are you not the servants of Saul? Choose a man and have him come down to me. ⁹If he is able to fight and kill me, we will become your subjects; but if I overcome him and kill him, you will become our subjects and serve us." ¹⁰Then the Philistine said, "This day I defy the armies of Israel! Give me a man and let us fight each other." ¹¹On hearing the Philistine's words, Saul and all the Israelites were dismayed and terrified.

II. Face Your Fear

- 1. Do not allow fear of the unknown hold us back.
- 2. We can either walk in victory and freedom, or we can be bound in fear.
- 3. Use the armor God has equipped us with to win our battles.

1 Samuel 17: 20-23 [NIV]

²⁰Early in the morning David left the flock in the care of a shepherd, loaded up and set out, as Jesse had directed. He reached the camp as the army was going out to its battle positions, shouting the war cry. ²¹Israel and the Philistines were drawing up their lines facing each other. ²²David left his things with the keeper of supplies, ran to the battle lines and asked his brothers how they were. ²³As he was talking with them, Goliath, the Philistine champion from Gath, stepped out from his lines and shouted his usual defiance, and David heard it.

III. Convert Your Fear into Faith

- 1. Trust God, let go and walk away.
- 2. Stay connected.
- 3. Remember the miracles of God as ones that feed new miracles.
- 4. Pray daily with a boldness moving closer to God and faith.

1 Samuel 17: 45-48 [NIV]

⁴⁵David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. ⁴⁶This day the Lord will deliver you into my hands, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. This very day I will give the carcasses of the Philistine army to the birds and the wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel. ⁴⁷All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the Lord saves; for the battle is the Lord's, and he will give all of you into our hands." ⁴⁸As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, David ran quickly toward the battle line to meet him.
