# Breakout - Part 5: The Setback Was a Setup

## **Ephesians 4:7-10 NIV**

<sup>7</sup> But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it. <sup>8</sup> This is why it says: "When he ascended on high, he took many captives and gave gifts to his people." <sup>9</sup> (What does "he ascended" mean except that he also descended to the lower, earthly regions? <sup>10</sup> He who descended is the very one who ascended higher than all the heavens, in order to fill the whole universe.)

# I. The Setback Was a Setup

- A. The resurrection of Jesus Christ (Revelation 1:18)
  - 1. Preceded by Jesus' birth and death, events that could have been perceived as setbacks
- B. His resurrection represents the beginning.

### **James 1:2-4**

<sup>2</sup> Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, <sup>3</sup> because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. <sup>4</sup> Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

### **Romans 5:3-5**

<sup>3</sup>Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; <sup>4</sup> perseverance, character; and character, hope. <sup>5</sup> And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who ahs been given to us.
