Exodus 15:26 [NKJV]

²⁶ I am The Lord God Who Heals You.

- First time in the Bible where God reveals himself as a healer.

John 1:1 [NKJV]

¹ In the beginning was the Word, the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14[a] [ISV]

¹⁴ The Word became flesh and lived among us...

- Today God is still doing what he did in Exodus, He is revealing himself as our Healer.
- God wants us to know he is not the author of confusion nor sickness.
- Mankind was never supposed to know sickness.
- When Adam ate the forbidden fruit he introduced the world to sin.

Isaiah 53:4-5 [ESV]

⁴ Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. ⁵ But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

- Yes, God wants us healed.
 - It is Gods will that not one shall perish and not one be lost.
- Jesus went about healing ALL who were sick, oppressed, blind, deaf...

Things to know about the Power of our God Who Heals Us

- We should let our hearts be at peace.
 - God did not take our loved ones;
 - God is not mad at us; and most importantly,
 - God has not forgotten about us.
- There is Natural healing: realizing God authority should change the way we think.
- There is Spiritual healing:

- Become intimate with your bible- know his Word, take notes, write in your Bible.
- God’s Word gives us authority to speak healing power over our lives.

Luke 9:1 [NKJV]

⁹ Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.

Luke 10:1 [NKJV]

¹ After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.

Luke 10:17-20 [NKJV]

¹⁷ Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.” ¹⁸And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. ¹⁹Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. ²⁰Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”
