Psalm 52:3c(1g) – Part 2

Psalm 52:3c(1g) God's lovingkindness is every day.

There it is... a short "tag line," just sitting out there like an orphan. In Hebrew it reads, "Chesed El Kol-Yom." It's a simple statement that will change your life. God, the maker of heaven and earth, looks upon you with favor every day. Solomon, who was the wisest man of all, wrote in Lamentations....

Lamentations 3:22 Because of the mercies (Chesed) of Adonai we will not be consumed, for His compassions never fail. 23 They are new every morning! Great is Your faithfulness.

Also written by Solomon, in Song of Songs, the Shulamite (symbolic of us) is looking with lovingkindness at her Beloved (symbolic of Yeshua). And, what's next? Her Beloved, Who is the Lord, is looking back at you with that same favor called "dove's eyes." Adonai's "tender mercies" (Chas'dei)... are new every morning!"

God looks upon us with favor and lovingkindness every day. What's better, His favor is based on grace not works. God loves you because that's who He is, not because of who we are. We don't deserve His love, we didn't earn it, but His favor is poured out on us just the same.

Titus 3:4 But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared— 5 not by deeds of righteousness which we had done ourselves, but because of His mercy—He saved us through the mikveh of rebirth and renewing of the Ruach ha-Kodesh, 6 whom He abundantly poured out on us through Messiah Yeshua our Savior,

May we never recover from such a complete blessing. God's promise is to pour out His grace upon you every day for all eternity. What, you were hoping for a greater blessing? There isn't any. Shalom shalom.
