The 4 Instructions

(Various sessions)

The 7 Crises of the Bride

(Various sessions)

- 1: 5-7 1st Crisis She has lost her first Love. She enters her 1st Crisis: There will be several.
- 2:8-15 2nd Crisis The Beloved calls for her to exit "self" & join Him in resurrection life. Her fears block her way.
- **2:17 3**rd **Crisis** She disobeys His call & tells Him to go on leaping without her on these Mts of Bether (separation). Her disobedience ushers in her next crisis.
- **4:6 4**th **Crisis** She steps back into obedience & pledges to follow Him.
- 5:6 5th Crisis Her Beloved calls to her (5:4) she hesitates, & He departs. She searches for Him & called out to him, but He doesn't answer. (Abandonment)
- 5:7 **6th Crisis** The watchmen who guard the city found her wondering about, they struck her wounded her & took her veil away from her. (Persecution)
- **7th Crisis** Return, return, O Shulamite; Return, return, that we may look upon you! This is her **Eph 2:10** destiny moment, created in Messiah, beforehand, for good deeds.

BOUGHT with BLOOD by Derek Prince

Derek Prince, in 'Bought with Blood", talks about the power of the "divinely ordained exchange" that takes place by grace, though faith he states: "At the cross an exchange took place, divinely ordained and predicted by God... All the evil due by justice to come to us came upon Yeshua, that all the good due to Yeshua, because of His sinless obedience, might be made available to us." Prince lists nine specific aspects of that exchange:

- 1. Yeshua was **punished** that we might be **forgiven**.
- 2. Yeshua was wounded that we might be healed.
- 3. Yeshua was made sin with our sinfulness that we might be made righteous with His righteousness.
- 4. Yeshua died our death that we might share His life.
- 5. Yeshua was made a curse that we might receive the blessing of His Spirit.
- **6.** Yeshua **endured our poverty** that we might **share His abundance**.
- 7. Yeshua bore our shame that we might share His glory.
- 8. Yeshua endured our rejection that we might enjoy His acceptance.
- 9. Our old man died in Yeshua that the new man might live in us.
