Let's Go to the Other Side

 Luke 8:22–25 (NKJV)

Theme: When storms arise in life, faith reminds us that Jesus is in the boat with us and has authority over every storm we face.

Key Scripture Reflection - Luke 8:25

“Who can this be? For He commands even the winds and water, and they obey Him!”

The disciples learned something powerful:

The same Jesus who allowed the storm also had power over the storm.

Sermon Points

I. Enable Your Awareness of Who's With You

 Luke 8:22

The disciples were afraid, but they forgot who was in the boat with them.

Reflection

Sometimes fear grows when we forget who is with us. Jesus being present means:

- We are not alone
- Our situation is not hopeless
- Our storm is not stronger than our Savior

Personal Reflection

Where do you need to remember that Jesus is with you right now?

II. Enable Acceptance of the Word Over Your Worries

 Luke 8:24

Jesus had already said: “Let us go over to the other side.”

That meant the storm could not cancel the destination.

Reflection: Worry focuses on the storm. Faith focuses on what Jesus said.

Application Question

What promise from God do you need to trust instead of your worry?

III. You Have Authority Over the Winds and the Waves

 Luke 8:24

Jesus spoke to the storm: “Peace, be still.” And immediately the wind and waves obeyed Him.

Reflection: The storm responded to the authority of Jesus.

Because we belong to Him:

- We can pray with confidence
- We can speak peace over chaos
- We can trust God’s power over our circumstances

Personal Reflection

What storm in your life needs to hear “Peace, be still”?

Life Application: Storms in life may look like:

- Stress and anxiety
- Health concerns
- Family challenges
- Financial pressure
- Uncertainty about the future

But today’s reminder is simple:

 Storms don’t cancel God’s plan.

 Jesus is still in the boat.

 And the other side is still ahead.

Weekly Challenge

This week when a storm arises, pause and say:

“Jesus is in my boat. I will trust Him to get me to the other side.”

Prayer: Lord, help me remember that You are with me in every storm. Give me faith to trust Your word over my worries and peace to rest in Your authority. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
