## TOGETHER FOR GOOD TRAINING

TOGETHER FOR GOOD IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT SERVES TO CREATE PATHWAYS FOR THE CHURCH TO COME ALONGSIDE VULNERABLE FAMILIES IN CHRIST-CENTERED MINISTRY. THEY DO THAT BY

- HOST FAMILIES ARE VOLUNTEERS WHO ACTUALLY HOST KIDS IN THEIR HOME TEMPORARILY WHILE MOM AND/OR DAD GET THE HELP THEY NEED. TYPICALLY THESE HOSTINGS ARE 1-3 DAYS, BUT IN SOME SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES WE DO HAVE LONGER HOSTINGS.
- SUPPORT VOLUNTEERS COME ALONGSIDE THESE FAMILIES IN PRAYER, BY PROVIDING MEALS, PROVIDING RIDES AND THROUGH MENTORSHIP. WITH THIS CONTINUUM OF CARE, THERE ARE OPPORTUNITIES FOR EVERYONE.

## HEART QUESTIONS

- Lets continue the conversation from last week about God's promises. Take some time to go around the room and share which promises are most meaningful to you right now and why.
- Often times we have to wait to see God's promises come to fruition. Talk about a time when you had to wait on God's promises to be fulfilled.
- Have someone re-read verse 16. How would you characterize this response from the people of Israel? What areas of your life do you sense God calling you to this same kind of response?


## Hand questians

- How does this passage answer the following questions:
- What am I to do?
- Who am I to become?
- Take some time in gender-specific groups tonight to encourage each other with God's faithful promises. How can we wait on God for the rest He promises when we trust Him?


## LEADER GUIDE

1. HANGOUT

SPEND SOME TIME AS PEOPLE COME INTO YOUR GROUP SPACE TO CATCH UP ON LIFE, ENJOY SOME SNACKS/COFFEE, AND CONNECT BEFORE YOU SIT DOWN FOR DISCUSSION.
PRO TIP: HAVE SOMEONE IN YOUR GROUP BE IN CHARGE OF SNACKS EACH WEEK. THIS DOESN'T HAVE TO BE UP TO YOU!

## 2. WELCOME

USE A SHORT TIME EACH WEEK TO WELCOME EVERYONE BACK AND TO WELCOME NEW members to the group and get to know THEM.

## 3. VISION/PURPOSE

THIS IS A TIME TO SHARE YOUR HEART AS A LEADER FOR THE PURPOSE OF YOUR GROUP AND THE KIND OF EXPERIENCE THIS IS AIMING TO BE.
PRO TIP: HAVE AN EMPTY CHAIR AT ALL OF YOUR MEETINGS AND SPORADICALLY POINT OUT THAT THAT IS THERE FOR THE NEXT PEOPLE WE INVITE INTO COMMUNITY WITH US. PRAY FOR THAT PERSON!

## 4. GENDER SPECIFIC GROUPS

SHARE LIFE UPDATES, HOLD EACH OTHER ACCOUNTABLE, AND PRAY TOGETHER IN GENDER-SPECIFIC GROUPS. THIS IS HELPFUL FOR OBEDIENCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY AND DEEPER DISCIPLESHIP.
BO TIP: MAKE SURE THAT PHONE NUMBERS HARED SO THAT GROUP MEMBERS CAN
5. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

USE A GOOD MIX OF HEAD, HEART, AND HAND QUESTIONS. THE GOAL IS NOT TO GET THROUGH EVERY SINGLE QUESTION, BUT TO USE THE QUESTIONS AS A TOOL TO HELP YOUR GROUP LET GOD'S WORD WORK INTO OUR MINDS, OUR HEARTS, AND OUR LIVES. PRO TIP: IN YOUR TIME OF PREPARATION, THINK OF SOME FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS YOU COULD ASK TO GO DEEPER WITH YOUR GROUP.

## HOT SEAT (OPTIONAL ACTIVITY)

SOMETIMES INSTEAD OF GENDER-SPECIFIC GROUP, SELECT A PERSON OR A COUPLE TO BE ON THE "HOT SEAT" IN YOUR LARGE GROUP. SET A TIMER FOR A MINIMUM OF 20 MINUTES. START THE TIMER AND BEGIN ASKING QUESTIONS. ANYONE CAN ASK ANYTHING, BUT THE PERSON ON THE HOT SEAT CAN ALSO PASS ON ANY QUESTION.
ONCE THE TIMER GOES OFF, ALLOW THE PERSON ON THE HOT SEAT TO FINISH THEIR CURRENT ANSWER.
TO FINISH THE HOT SEAT ROUND, SELECT A FEW PEOPLE TO pray for the person/people on the hot seat. discussion or after group! church center (via the planning center groups app)
