# CONNECTION GROUP <br> Questions <br> Week Of: 4/2/23 

IMPORTANT: Take some time before you group discussion starts to tell your people about some things happening in mosaic life coming soon. We'll continue to have these a part of the beginnings of our CG's. These are found on the first page.

## HEAR QUESTIORS

- ICEBREAKER: What is something that you are loyal to (a person, team, cause, organization or the like; NO POLITICAL DISCOURSE HERE PLEASE)? What does that look like?
- Read Joshua 23:1-11 together. What is happening in this passage?
- What are the elements of loyalty that Joshua is calling the Israelites to?


## HEART QUESTIANS

**As we talk about sensitive issues together, it might be best to break into guys/girls groups.

- Read Joshua 24:14-24 together. Why does Joshua call the Israelites to choose whom they will worship?
- In what ways do we struggle to be "ALL-IN" in our worship of God in our daily lives? How are you prone to wander in your loyalty to worshiping God alone?
- How do we (both individuals and as a group) respond to realizing we are not being loyal to God? How should we?


## Hand quEstIans

- How have you experienced "Church Membership" in the past? What do you believe is important about membership in a local church?
- What are some questions you would have about what mosaic Family Membership is? (encourage people to write these down and I can collect those questions from you as we seek to answer these in the coming weeks)
- This is a good space to share about upcoming mosaic Family Membership classes in May.


## LEADER GUIDE

1. HANGOUT

SPEND SOME TIME AS PEOPLE COME INTO YOUR GROUP SPACE TO CATCH UP ON LIFE, ENJOY SOME SNACKS/COFFEE, AND CONNECT BEFORE YOU SIT DOWN FOR DISCUSSION.
PRO TIP: HAVE SOMEONE IN YOUR GROUP BE IN CHARGE OF SNACKS EACH WEEK. THIS DOESN'T HAVE TO BE UP TO YOU!

## 2. WELCOME

USE A SHORT TIME EACH WEEK TO WELCOME EVERYONE BACK AND TO WELCOME NEW members to the group and get to know THEM.

## 3. VISION/PURPOSE

THIS IS A TIME TO SHARE YOUR HEART AS A LEADER FOR THE PURPOSE OF YOUR GROUP AND THE KIND OF EXPERIENCE THIS IS AIMING TO BE.
PRO TIP: HAVE AN EMPTY CHAIR AT ALL OF YOUR MEETINGS AND SPORADICALLY POINT OUT THAT THAT IS THERE FOR THE NEXT PEOPLE WE INVITE INTO COMMUNITY WITH US. PRAY FOR THAT PERSON!

## 4. GENDER SPECIFIC GROUPS

SHARE LIFE UPDATES, HOLD EACH OTHER ACCOUNTABLE, AND PRAY TOGETHER IN GENDER-SPECIFIC GROUPS. THIS IS HELPFUL FOR OBEDIENCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY AND DEEPER DISCIPLESHIP.
BO TIP: MAKE SURE THAT PHONE NUMBERS HARED SO THAT GROUP MEMBERS CAN
5. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

USE A GOOD MIX OF HEAD, HEART, AND HAND QUESTIONS. THE GOAL IS NOT TO GET THROUGH EVERY SINGLE QUESTION, BUT TO USE THE QUESTIONS AS A TOOL TO HELP YOUR GROUP LET GOD'S WORD WORK INTO OUR MINDS, OUR HEARTS, AND OUR LIVES. PRO TIP: IN YOUR TIME OF PREPARATION, THINK OF SOME FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS YOU COULD ASK TO GO DEEPER WITH YOUR GROUP.

LAYOUT TWO HOURS OR (HOUR 1/2)
TIME STAMP EXAMPLES: 6-8P (6-7:30P)

6:00-6:15 (6:00-6:10)-HANG-OUT

6:15-6:25 (6:10-6:20) - WELCOME/VISION \& PURPOSE

6:25-6:55 (6:20-6:40) - GENDER SPECIFIC GROUPS

6:55-7:45 (6:40-7:20) -SERMON BASED DISCUSSION

7:45-8:00 (7:20-7:30) - PRAYER \& ANNOUNCEMENTS

## HOT SEAT (OPTIONAL ACTIVITY)

SOMETIMES INSTEAD OF GENDER-SPECIFIC GROUP, SELECT A PERSON OR A COUPLE TO BE ON THE "HOT SEAT" IN YOUR LARGE GROUP. SET A TIMER FOR A MINIMUM OF 20 MINUTES. START THE TIMER AND BEGIN ASKING QUESTIONS. ANYONE CAN ASK ANYTHING, BUT THE PERSON ON THE HOT SEAT CAN ALSO PASS ON ANY QUESTION.
ONCE THE TIMER GOES OFF, ALLOW THE PERSON ON THE HOT SEAT TO FINISH THEIR CURRENT ANSWER.
TO FINISH THE HOT SEAT ROUND, SELECT A FEW PEOPLE TO pray for the person/people on the hot seat. discussion or after group! church center (via the planning center groups app)
