- 1. Hell is real and it is torture. Luke 17:19-24
- 2. A life of <u>luxury</u> can lead to an eternity of <u>misery</u>. Luke 17:25-28
- 3. Listen to the <u>truth</u> and <u>repent</u> today. Luke 17:29-31

Discussion Questions

- 1. If you could have a conversation with anyone who is dead, who would you want to talk to and what would you ask them or say to them?
- 2. Do you believe in Hell? Why or why not? How can a loving God send people to Hell? What's the difference in the way our culture describes Hell and what the Bible says about it?
- 3. If you had to choose, which would you choose: 1) a life of luxury here and now or 2) an eternity of peace and comfort? What would our lifestyles and daily focus indicate about which one we are choosing?
- 4. Who do you trust for advice and why? How can you help your people navigate life and eternity? How important and urgent has a life pleasing to God and the eternal destiny for you and those you love been? What will you do in response to this text and who's on your heart for heaven?
