1. Jesus _____ resurrection.

“Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies;²⁶ and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?”

John 11:25-26

2. Jesus _____ resurrection.

“Jesus, once more deeply moved, came to the tomb. It was a cave with a stone laid across the entrance. ³⁹“Take away the stone,” he said. “But, Lord,” said Martha, the sister of the dead man, “by this time there is a bad odor, for he has been there four days.”

John 11:38-39

“When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, “Lazarus, come out!” ⁴⁴ The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Jesus said to them, “Take off the grave clothes and let him go.”

John 11:43-44

3. Jesus _____ resurrection.

“Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance.”

John 20:1

“He saw the strips of linen lying there,⁷ as well as the cloth that had been around Jesus’ head. The cloth was folded up by itself, separate from the linen.”

John 20:6b-7

“Finally the other disciple, who had reached the tomb first, also went inside. He saw and believed. ⁹ (They still did not understand from Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead.)”

John 20:8

“At this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realize that it was Jesus.”

¹⁶ Jesus said to her, “Mary.”
