JESUS SHARES A TEMPLATE FOR HOW DISCIPLES SHOULD PRAY

5 “And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward.

6 But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who *is* in the secret *place*; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.

7 And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen *do*. For they think that they will be heard for their many words.

8 “Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.

9 In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

MATTHEW 6:5-15

14 “For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.

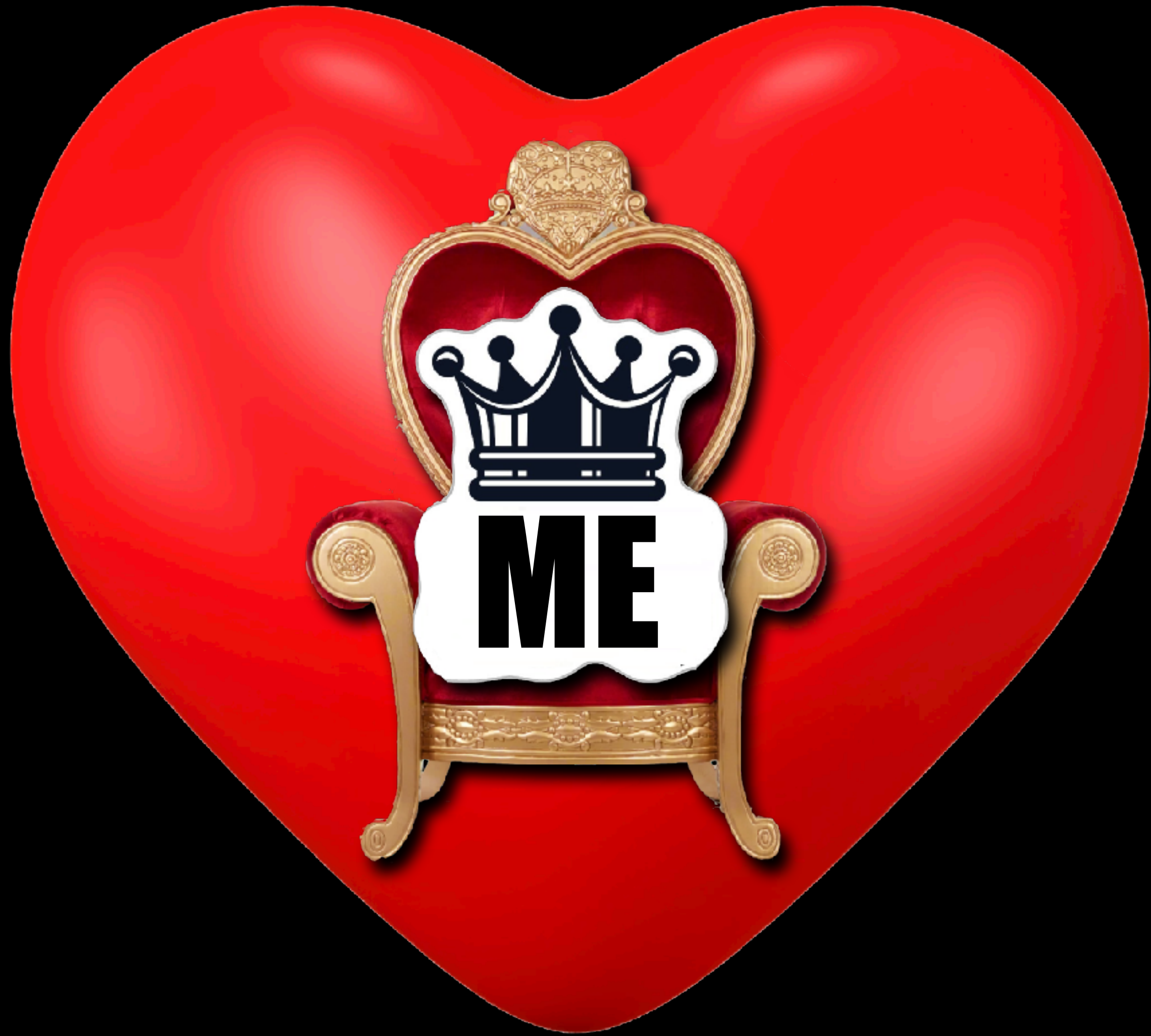

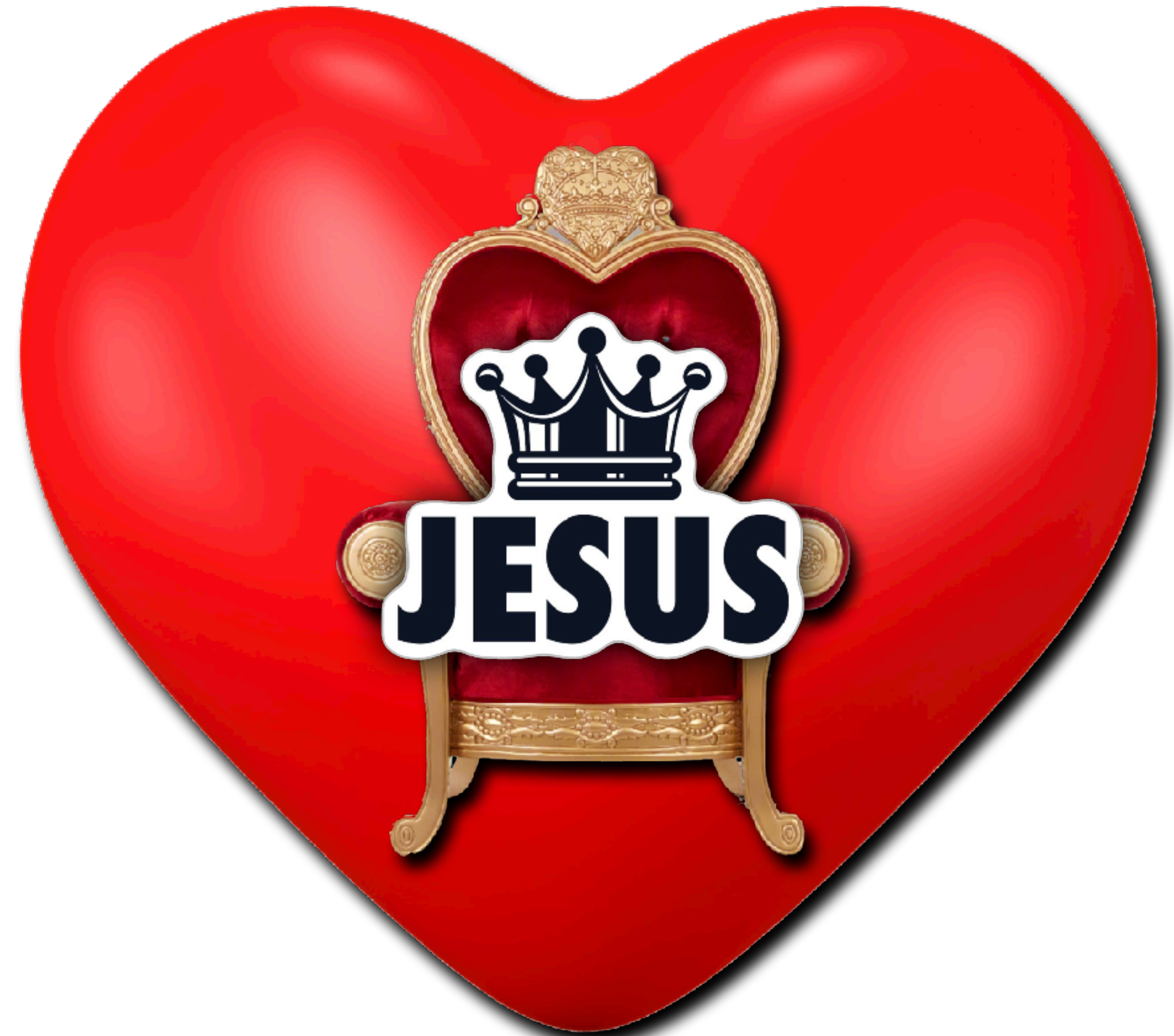

1. **DO** - PRAY TO JESUS IN A REAL WAY

Matthew Chapter 18:21-35

Two important aspects of forgiveness:

I must receive forgiveness from God.

I must forgive others.

1. Our forgiveness of others is commanded by Jesus (vs. 21-22)
2. Our forgiveness of others is to be unlimited (vs. 22)
3. Our forgiveness of others is to be based on God's example (vs. 23-33)
4. Our forgiveness of others is to extend to everyone (vs. 35)
5. If we do not forgive others, our Father will not forgive us (vs. 35)

VARIOUS GREEK WORDS TRANSLATED “GIFT” IN ENGLISH

δωρεά (*dorea*)

Usually used speaking of The Gift of The Holy Spirit

χάρισμα (*charisma*)

Romans 12 the list of primary or motivational gifts

πνευματικός (*numa-tikos*)

1 Corinthians 12 an expanded list includes diversities, differences, but the manifestation of the Spirit

μερισμοῖς (*merismos*)

Hebrews 2:3-4 attributes some signs, wonders, miracles, and gifts that accompanied the earthly ministry of Jesus Christ

LIST OF GIFTS (PNEUMATIKOS) 1 CORINTHIANS 12

The expanded list here in 1 Corinthians 12 includes diversities, differences, but the manifestation of the Spirit

1. vs8 - Word of Wisdom

Divine revelation of wisdom pertaining to a specific circumstance or situation

2. vs8 - Word of Knowledge

Divine relegation of knowledge pertaining to a specific circumstance or situation

3. vs9 - Faith

Belief, trust

4. vs9 - Healings (*plural*)

Remedies, healings, medicine

5. vs10 - Workings of Miracles *(plural)*

Supernatural works

6. vs10 - Prophecy

A discourse emanating from divine inspiration and declaring the purposes of God, whether by reproving and admonishing the wicked, or comforting the afflicted, or revealing things hidden; esp. by foretelling future events

7. vs10 - Discerning of Spirits

To supernaturally distinguish, perceive, recognize

8. vs10 - Variety of Tongues & vs28

The ability to speak known languages and/or to speak heavenly prayer languages

9. vs10 - Interpretation of Tongues

The ability interpret known languages and/or to interpret heavenly prayer languages

10. vs28 - Helps

Aid, help, support

11. vs10 - Administrations

Directing, administrations, organizing

LIST OF GIFTS (PNEUMATIKOS) 1 CORINTHIANS 12

Some important notes:

- a. All Spiritual gifts and the many diversities, differences, and manifestation in the Spirit are for the edification of others in the body of Christ, with the exception of the gift of tongues as a heavenly prayer language. “He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church.” 1 Corinthians 14:4
This is the most-likely reason that Paul dissuaded the Corinthian church from speaking tongues in church services without interpretations.
- b. In 1 Corinthians 12:28-31, Paul asks a series of rhetorical questions indicating that not all believers will exercise every gift and then he points us to the one and only motive behind every gift; love. Love assures that the correct gift matches the need.
- c. We are vessels that are used by the Lord, like a paint brush in the hand of a master artist, or a scalpel in the hand of a master surgeon. As believers, we are only stewards of any/all gifts, callings, talents that He entrusts to our care.

Some important notes:

- a. Those that the Lord calls to fulfill the five offices are gifted by God for the equipping of the saints, for the work of the ministry (*Ephesians 4:12*).
- b. Unity in the body of Christ is realized when each member of the body of Christ discovers their calling, gifts, and matures to the point that each member does their share.
- c. For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. (*Romans 11:29*)
