We must understand three crucial elements if we are to be successful witnesses in today's culture.

- 1. The first step is to gain a solid understanding of the Kingdom.
 - a. The kingdom of God must be the fundamental life goal that everyone should seek and align with.
 - b. The kingdom of God, in its most basic form, is the authority of Jesus Christ as Lord and King in our life.
 - c. The kingdom is a personal encounter with God.
- 2. The second step is to recognize what the church is and is not.
 - a. A local church is a gathering of Christians in a specific location.
 - b. The church is one of God's most powerful and effective tools.
 - c. Our church exists exclusively to establish God's kingdom, His rule and reign, in the lives of those who live in the community in which we live.
 - d. Contrary to popular belief, the church does not exist just for the sake of the church.
- 3. The third step is to remain focused on the Kingdom agenda.
 - a. Stewardship and ministry are the two cornerstones of a kingdom-focused church.
 - b. Stewardship is vertical in the sense that a local church is subject to the Father's authority and will.
 - c. A church's ministry is horizontal in the sense that it focuses on people.
 - d. Jesus had a laser-like focus. The salvation of all humans who lived on Earth at any time was His primary priority.
 - e. Above everything, we must prioritize bringing individuals into the kingdom. We must be evangelists for Jesus Christ.
