

SOAP DEVOTIONS

Opening a Bible and reading it is how we hear God speak to us. Evergreen Church follows a Bible reading plan and a simple four step method to write down what God says. First we read the Bible passage listed for the day. We write down four things.

Scripture — just one verse that feels like it was written just for you.

Observation — what is God saying in that verse?

Application — how will my life be different because of what I just read?

Prayer — what's your heart response to God?
