Habakkuk Chapter 2. Four things to learn.

1. Soon and very soon. Vs 1-8.

A. Expect God to <u>answer</u> when you pray. Vs 1-2.

B. God's timing is not our timing, it's <u>better</u>! Vs 3.

C. God's judgement is <u>irreversible</u>. Vs 4-8.

2. All is seen. Vs 9-11.

A. The self-serving shall be rewarded. Vs 9

B. Those who <u>abuse</u> others shall judged. Vs 10

3. What goes around, comes around. Vs 12-17.

A. Glory of man, Glory of God. Vs 12-14.

B. As you judge <u>others</u>, so, God will judge <u>you</u>. Vs 15-17.

4. Man made god, or God made man? Vs 18-20.

A. Why make gods in our <u>own image</u>? Vs 18.

- B. Our gods cannot help us. Vs 19.
- C. There is only one true God. Vs 20.

3 Conclusions:

1. God's timing is always right even when it seems wrong.

2. Nothing passes God's attention.

3. There are two god's in the world, the god of our making, or The One True God who made us, which one are you serving?
