The All-Seeing Eyes of God

Exodus 2:25

Nothing escapes the eye of God. From that which is done on the largest stage in the universe to that which is done in private behind closed doors, God sees and knows all things. God knows us better than we know ourselves. For believers, God's all-seeing eye is a great comfort but for unbelievers, it is something that should cause them great concern.

Zacchaeus and Nathanael

Zacchaeus and Nathanael are 2 positive examples of God seeing and knowing His people. Our salvation is possible because God Himself has sought us out. God sees us long before we see Him. God knows us long before we know a single thing about ourselves. Zacchaeus climbed so that he could see Jesus but it is Jesus who looks up and sees him! Christ doesn't just see Zacchaeus; He already knows Zacchaeus! Jesus saw Nathanael in the one place that no one would look for him. He saw him in the place where he would go to be alone with God. Jesus didn't just see Nathanael; He saw the heart of Nathanael. God has seen you where you are and He sees where you are going.

Sodom and Gomorrah

God sees every act of hatred, mockery, sin, and destruction. God is a God of justice and He will not allow one sin to go unaccounted for. Sinners have not escaped the eye of God. We must understand, the wrath of God is coming. He has seen what is happening on the face of the Earth and the moment is coming where He will act in judgment. God looked at the acts of Sodom and Gomorrah and brought judgment upon them. God will see to it that every single person receives a fair trial.

What Unbelievers Must Understand

We must understand that God's wrath could be poured out at any moment. No one will escape judgment and the time to act is running short. To escape the wrath that is to come, man must be born again! Just because there is peace now does not mean that one has escaped judgment. The only thing that we can do is trust that God would continue to be patient and continue to be merciful, even to those that do not deserve it. The time is coming where God's patience with unbelievers will run out.
