Luke 3:21,22	Jordan River with John the Baptist and possible crowd	Jesus’ Baptism	?	Holy Spirit descended on Him as he was praying. God poke from heaven
Mark 1:35	Early in the morning while it was dark Solitary Place	In the midst of ministry	?	Everyone was looking for Him, put He was focused on prayer
Luke 6:12	Mountainside All night long	Before he chose His disciples	?	He chose 12 men from all the disciples
Luke 9:18	In private Disciples with Him	Ask the disciples who He is.	?	A turning point in Jesus’ ministry with his disciples
Luke 9:29	Mountainside Peter, James, John with Him	The Transfiguration	?’	A highlight in Jesus’ ministry with these men
Matthew 11:24-27	?	Jesus talking about John the Baptist	Praises God for revealing truth to the humble rather than wise	Listed as a prayer because Jesus talks to the Father
Luke 11:1	Certain Place With His disciples	Disciples ask Him to teach them to pray	?	Gives His disciples the Lord’s Pray as a model
Matthew 14:19= Mark 6-32-44; Luke 9:10-17; John 6:1-13	Desert near Bethsaida on the east side of the Sea of Galilee	Feeding 5,000	Jesus blessed the food	The only miracle of Jesus in all four gospels
Matthew 14:23 = Mark 6:46	Mountainside By Himself	After feeding the 5,000 Before He walks of water	?	Jesus sent the disciples into the storm, but prayed for them, and came to them
Matthew 19:13	With a crowd of children	People wanted Jesus to place His hands on the children and pray for them	?	Disciples didn’t want it, but Jesus prayed for them.
John 11:41-42	Bethany	Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead	Thanks the Father for hearing Him.	Prays out loud so the people will hear Him and believe
John 12:27,28	Jerusalem	After the Triumphal Entry	Considers asking the Father to save Him for the hour to come, but instead prays for the Father's glory	

Luke 22:32	?	The Last Supper	That Peter's faith would not fail	Jesus prayed for his own when one was facing a trial
Matt. 26:36-45 = Mark 14:32-41 = Luke 22:39-46	By Himself with disciples nearby	Gethsemane	"May this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will."	He was overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Ask for disciples help Prayed with face to the ground
John 17:1-26	With His disciples Looked toward heaven and prayed	The Last Supper Immediately before going to Gethsemane	vv.1-5 Glorify your Son Jesus says he has brought glory to the Father by doing the work the Father gave Him. vv.6-19 Jesus prays for Disciples Jesus says he prays not for the world, but for those the Father gave him. He prays for them to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be protected from the evil one • be one • have the full measure of His joy • be sanctified vv. 20-26 Jesus prays for all Believers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He prays for us: • to be one • to be with Jesus and see his glory • that the Father's love and Jesus will be in us 	
Luke 23:24	Golgotha as Jesus is being nailed to the cross	The crucifixion	Asks the Father to forgive His executioners
