4 Cups

- Sanctification - “I will bring you out”
- Deliverance - “I will free you from being slaves”
- Redemption - “I will redeem you with an outstretched arm”
- Cup of protection - “I will take you as my own people”

Cup of Sanctification

1. Washing

- Cleanse my mind so my thoughts would be your thoughts
- Cleanse my heart so my desires would be your desires
- Cleanse my hands that I might do the things you have for me
- Cleanse my feet that I might walk in your ways
