DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Who are the people who influence the big decisions that you make? Relational decisions? Financial decisions? Future decisions?
- 2. Have there ever been any instances that a stranger influenced an important decision in your life? Tell of that time.
- 3. Do you agree with the statement human influence is based on relationship? That the deeper the relationship, the deeper the influence and the more their influence impacts you? Why is this true or false?
- 4. Because of the increasing hostility of the religious Pharisees, Jesus stopped going to the Synagogues to teach. Instead, He began preaching in the countrysides. Put yourself in the shoes of the Pharisees. Why would Jesus make you angry?
- 5. How is Jesus' treatment of this man probably different than the way others have treated him?
- 6. How did the pig farmers respond? The townspeople? Why? How would you have responded?
- 7. May times people put off talking about Jesus because they think they don't know enough. How much did the demon-possessed guy who is now sane know about Jesus?

THINK ABOUT IT
