DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is something that you used to be really good at, but now you are out of practice?
2. Read Matthew 4:4. How does Jesus' statement explain the importance of reading God's Word?
3. What does Joshua 1:8 instruct us to do with God's Word that we may be careful to do it?
4. How can talking, asking and listening in prayer change the way you hear from and communicate with God?
5. How does obeying God prepare you to be able to receive more from God?
6. Practice is the key to permanence. How can you begin practicing the things you have learned to better hear from God?
7. In the message, Carlo said, "So many people want a new word from God and they haven't done anything with what God has already said." What has God spoken to you during this series? How can we help you do something with that word?

Moving Forward

This week: Develop a rhythm with God (daily), schedule at least 5 minutes to pray, and take a step today toward obeying something that God has specially instructed you to do.
