5. Is there any pain in your life that you're ready for God to bring to an end? If so, what is it?
6. What's your vision of what heaven will be like?
7. How does it make you feel knowing that the God of the universe wants to live with you forever?
8. Why do you think so many people choose to take the broad road that leads to destruction?
