## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. What goal have you been trying to accomplish this year? What bad habits have you been trying to stop? What healthy habits have you been trying to start? What do you think is holding you back?
- 2. Over the last 3 weeks, we have looked at 7 sins/spiders and 7 virtues. What has God taught you about how these spiders and virtues affect our lives? (Pride, envy, anger, greed, gluttony, lust, and sloth)
- 3. What does it mean to be slothful or lazy? How does it only focus on the present moment? What does it mean to be diligent?
- 4. With your Bible or Bible App, Proverbs 10:4, 10:26, 12:24, 13:4, 20:4.

Lazy people are soon poor; hard workers get rich. Lazy people irritate their employers, like vinegar to the teeth or smoke in the eyes. Work hard and become a leader; be lazy and become a slave. Lazy people want much but get little, but those who work hard will prosper. Those too lazy to plow in the right season will have no food at the harvest.
