- 1. What is one of your favorite proverbs or trustworthy sayings, whether from the Bible or another source? How has it influenced your perspective on life?
- 2. With the Bible or Bible App, read the following Proverbs:

Let someone else praise you, not your own mouth—a stranger, not your own lips.	Proverbs 27:2
Pride ends in destruction; humility ends in honor.	Proverbs 18:12
Pride goes before destruction, and haughtiness before a fall.	Proverbs 16:18
The fear of the Lord teaches a man wisdom, and humility comes before honor.	Proverbs 15:33
Pride leads to disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom.	Proverbs 11:2

- 3. God and people resist the proud. So, how do you know if you are proud?
- 4. Talk about a time when you have seen "be humble or be humbled" play out.
- 5. What are some indicators that someone is secure? What are some indicators that someone is insecure?
- 6. What does it look like to take the low place at work? At home? In other relationships?
- 7. In which environments or situations are you most susceptible to experiencing envy and insecurity? How do you fight against them?
- 8. How can you celebrate others in your areas of influence? How can you encourage one another to practice humility this week?

Humility is not something we possess. It is something we practice. It takes effort and intention, but it's worth it. Humility keeps us from the path of disgrace and leads us toward honor.
