- Faith was defining who would determine the outcome
- God's Word is more reliable than circumstances around us
- Come expecting! Expectation is what we do
- The word has been spoken and it's what matters
- Respond to God's invitation
- The enemy still attacks expectation. His strategy hasn't changed
- Obedience is restored when confidence in God's Word is restored
- Have confidence in the Leader
- God gives us enough light for the next step
- Leave that familiar place you know
- Details can become distracting
- Obedience is always a revelation to what we think God is worth
- The greater the revelation, the quicker obedience comes in
- Obedience is no longer measured by what it costs us
- We need a fresh revelation of who He is
- Obedience often asks us to sacrifice something
- I'm going to believe what God said, not what I see
- Act before people understand
- Don't be surprised when obedience looks foolish before fruitful
- Can you obey?
