Ruth 2

- As long as Ruth stayed in Boaz's fields, she wouldn't have anything to worry about
- She fell on her face, bowed down because she found his favor.
- Ruth did it to honor Boaz and his kindness
- It was an outward sign of her inward thankfulness, as is our worship to God
- Here is a God that allowed me to feel Him in a way I had no right to
- Do we ever just bow before Him and thank Him for being so gracious and kind?
- Thinking about the life we deserve instead of the life He has given us brings us to worship
- Boaz treated Ruth as if she mattered
- She demonstrated her thankfulness in her posture and her praise
- You reap what you sow
- The gratitude of her heart expressed itself in her actions
- Worship is always an external evidence of what is happening in the inner man
- When the heart is truly thankful, it expresses itself in acts of worship
- When we fail to worship, we reveal the condition of our heart
- What's on the inside is going to be portrayed on the outside
- How can we stand in the presence of the One who has been so gracious and so merciful to us and not worship Him?
- We don't deserve His goodness any more than Ruth did
- She committed herself to the unknown, trusting in God
