- Scripture is given to us for teaching, reproof, correction, and instruction in righteousness
- He gave us His Word so we can become more like Him. So we can be complete, prepared, equipped, and ready
- The scriptures provide everything I need
- Let your life be an example. Your conduct matters
- I cannot separate spiritual maturity from what comes out of my mouth
- Get scripture in your heart
- The Word provides boundaries and guidelines
- When there is fruit on a tree, it's self evident. You can easily tell what kind of tree it is
- What fruit are we growing?
- The fruit of the Spirit should be hanging from our branches
- There will be something visible in the way that we treat one another
- Keep your flesh under subjection
