- Christ in us. We need to have some resemblance of Him in our life
- Is it okay to just say "I am a Christian?"
- We have to truly follow the example of Jesus
- Do the will of the Father
- Many who claim to follow Him will be rejected for lack of genuine devotion and relationship
- Does He live inside you?
- A Spirit filled life is a life that is surrendered to God
- We are not to live after the flesh. It was the flesh that once held us in bondage
- We must crucify the flesh
- God will not fill a man until he has emptied himself of himself
- A person's environment will leave a mark on how a person lives
- Jesus paid for the sins of mankind. He's the ultimate sacrifice
- Only blood can cover sin
- The fickle nature of people still exists today
- None shared in His suffering
- They nailed Him to the cross even though He'd done nothing wrong
