Acts 19:40

"For indeed we are in danger of being accused of a riot in connection with today's events,

Acts 26:2

"In regard to all the things of which I am accused by the Jews, I consider myself fortunate, King Agrippa, that I am about to make my defense before you today;

justifies - *dikaioo* - to make right; to make as if we haven't sinned oo = to do so that all may see

3. God Will Never Betray Us

condemns - katakrino - Romans 8:33; 8:1

to pronounce judgment or sentence against; to condemn when one is guilty of a charge

4. God's Love Does Not Spare Us From Times of Trouble

John 16:33

"These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world."

tribulation -that which squeezes us from the outside (including pressures that come from life)

distress - the inner stress that we go through because of the outward pressure upon us

persecution - *diode* - to pursue with the intent to kill or harm

famine - *leemos* - hunger; starvation

peril - the threat of death

sword - the executioner's sword used to put to death

5. God's Love Does Not Forsake Us In Times of Trouble

overwhelmingly conquer - super conquerors; those who defeat totally

6. God's Love Is Guaranteed To Us In All Times of Trouble
