THE WORD IS TRUTH

The Bible was written by men divinely inspired. It is God's revelation of Himself to man and His divine instruction for man. It has God for its author, salvation for its end; it has truth without any mixture of error for its matter. All Scripture is totally true and trustworthy. All Scripture is a testimony to Christ who is the focus of divine revelation.

2 Timothy 3:16-17

The truth/validity of the Bible is affirmed by:

1. Evidence of authority - there are no proven errors or inconsistencies in the Bible. Most "errors" are difficulties that have been cleared up by new information (like archeological discoveries) or an in-depth study of the text.

Nothing in science has ever disproved the Bible; in fact, confirmation of Biblical truth can be found in the sciences (biology, geology, astronomy, and archeology).

2. Evidence of transmission and preservation - the Bible has more partial and complete copies that any other document in all of antiquity. The oldest copies of the New Testament go back to 125 A.D. (less than 100 years after the completion of the New Testament). The only variations in any texts are spelling or word order. Many world leaders and governments have tried to undermine, discredit or destroy the Bible; it has outlasted any other work, it cannot be destroyed.

3. Evidence of prophecy - the Bible is the only book that contains specific, detailed prophecies that are 100% accurate. The Bible is the only religious book that contains predictive prophecy. The prophecies in the Bible were written hundreds of years before their completely accurate fulfillment. The prophecies about Jesus alone clearly have a supernatural element to their fulfillment (the science of probability reveals the fulfillment of those prophecies in one man could not have happened apart from a supernatural agent).


