THE WORD IS TRUTH: A GOSPEL CONVERSATION

Remember that many people are antagonistic toward the Bible. Don't get offended by what they say. Listen well. Try to understand what has happened in their life to turn them from the Lord, His Word, the church. This understanding can give you direction on how to talk with them.

Most people who have issues with the Bible's inaccuracies or errors really don't have specific instances but are parroting what they have heard. Recognize that the problem most people have with God's Word is that it brings them to accountability for their sin and how they live life – they really prefer to have their own god.

When it comes to defending the Bible, these proofs are most helpful:

- 1. The Bible's accuracy has been proven historically. Jewish historians who were alive at the time the Bible was written have recorded the same events.
- 2. The Bible's accuracy has been proven by archeology. The people, places, and dates recorded in the OT have been verified by archeological discoveries.
- 3. While the Bible is not a science textbook, nothing in any field of science has ever disproven or contradicted the Bible. (Remember, it is the theory of evolution).
- 4. Any difficulties or "inconsistencies" in the Bible are able to be resolved by in-depth study.
- 5. Predictive prophecy is conclusive proof of the supernatural content of the Bible and it's absolute truthfulness and trustworthiness.


