Systematic Theology - Lesson 8 Doctrine of Providence (Part 2)

1. Review of Providence (Lesson 7)

Providence refers to God's almighty, ever-present power by which He:

- Upholds heaven, earth, and all creatures
- Governs all events
- Preserves creation
- Works in and through all things
- Directs everything to His appointed purpose

Attributes of Providence:

- 1. Preservation God sustains all things.
- 2. Concurrence God works through all actions.
- 3. Government God directs all things.

2. Key Questions of Providence

- How do sovereignty and human freedom work together?
- If God is sovereign, why are humans accountable?
- How can God be good while evil exists?

3. Three Biblical Propositions

- I. God Is Absolutely Sovereign
 - Ps 115:2-3; Ps 135:6; Ps 139:16; Dan 4:34-35; Eph 1:11
 - God directs natural processes and human rulers.
 - God is sovereign over evil but never the author of it.
- II. Humans Are Morally Responsible
 - Our choices are real; we are accountable.
 - God commands all people to repent (Acts 17:30–31).

III. God Is Perfectly Good

- God is light; no darkness is in Him (1 John 1:5).
- God is righteous and good (Ps 92:15; Ps 145:9; James 1:13).

4. Compatibilism: How the Truths Fit Together

- God is sovereign.
- Man is responsible.
- Both are taught in Scripture and are compatible.

Carson's Two Statements:

- 1. Sovereignty never cancels responsibility.
- 2. Responsibility never makes God contingent.
