2 Samuel 24:18-25, KJV

Subject: Leadership Matters

2Sa 24:18 And Gad came that day to David, and said unto him, Go up, rear an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Araunah the Jebusite.

2Sa 24:19 And David, according to the saying of Gad, went up as the LORD commanded.

<u>2Sa 24:20</u> And Araunah looked, and saw the king and his servants coming on toward him: and Araunah went out, and bowed himself before the king on his face upon the ground.

<u>2Sa 24:21</u> And Araunah said, Wherefore is my lord the king come to his servant? And David said, To buy the threshingfloor of thee, to build an altar unto the LORD, that the plague may be stayed from the people.

<u>2Sa 24:22</u> And Araunah said unto David, Let my lord the king take and offer up what *seemeth* good unto him: behold, *here be* oxen for burnt sacrifice, and threshing instruments and *other* instruments of the oxen for wood.

2Sa 24:23 All these *things* did Araunah, *as* a king, give unto the king. And Araunah said unto the king, The LORD thy God accept thee.

<u>2Sa 24:24</u> And the king said unto Araunah, Nay; but I will surely buy *it* of thee at a price: neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the LORD my God of that which doth cost me nothing. So David bought the threshingfloor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver.

<u>2Sa 24:25</u> And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD was intreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel.

Sermon Points:

- 1. Hear through the SPIRIT...not the man (vss 18-19)
- 2. See through the SPIRIT...not your thoughts (vss 20-23)
- 3. Touched by the SPIRIT...not your emotions (vss 24-25)

Leadership Styles

- 1. **Servant leadership** this style serve others, they don't prioritize their own objectives; rather, they set aside their personal interests for the good of others.
- 2. Autocratic leadership this style makes decisions without the influence of others.
- 3. Transformational leadership this style is one who inspires positive change in individuals.
- 4. Transactional leadership this style a quid pro quo (Latin for "something for something") style.
- 5. Adaptive leadership this style adapts well to change. It is pliable enough to modify and adjust so as the environment shift and evolves, changes are maneuvered successfully.
- 6. Laissez-faire leadership this is a hands-off style. It promotes decision-making by others with minimal input from the leader.
- 7. **Democratic leadership** this style enables everyone to exchange ideas and have their opinions heard, but the leader still provides direction.
- 8. Bureaucratic leadership this style are rule followers. They value defined roles and responsibilities.
