## Jeremiah 29:4-11, NKJV

Subject: God's Plan

<u>Jer 29:4</u> Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, to all who were carried away captive, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem to Babylon:

Jer 29:5 Build houses and dwell *in them*; plant gardens and eat their fruit.

<u>Jer 29:6</u> Take wives and beget sons and daughters; and take wives for your sons and give your daughters to husbands, so that they may bear sons and daughters—that you may be increased there, and not diminished.

<u>Jer 29:7</u> And seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive, and pray to the LORD for it; for in its peace you will have peace.

<u>Jer 29:8</u> For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are in your midst deceive you, nor listen to your dreams which you cause to be dreamed.

<u>Jer 29:9</u> For they prophesy falsely to you in My name; I have not sent them, says the LORD.

<u>Jer 29:10</u> For thus says the LORD: After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to return to this place.

<u>Jer 29:11</u> For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
