Build It

What You Need:

- ❑ Large cardboard blocks
- ❑ Blankets, sheets, or play silks
- ❑ Pillows
- ❑ Chairs or a small table to use as a frame

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Place all the building materials in an open area of your room.

During the Activity: Invite the children to help you build a special fort or "house." Drape blankets over chairs or build walls with blocks. Make it a cozy and special place. Once it's built, invite them to go inside.

After the Activity: Introduce the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Friends, let's build something wonderful together! We're going to make a super special place, just for us."

During the Activity: "Let's use these blocks to make a wall. Can you help me? (*Build together.*) Now let's add a roof with this big blanket! (*Drape a blanket over it.*) Wow! This place looks so special. Let's go inside! (*Gather inside the fort.*) This fort is so cool! It's fun to be in a special place together."

After the Activity: "This fort is a really special place we made. But in our Bible Story, we learn that Jesus is preparing an even MORE special place for us called Heaven. Let's go hear about it!"

Yes or No

What You Need:

- A bag or box
- Adhesive bandage
- Sad face drawing
- Toy thermometer
- Happy face drawing
- Heart cutout
- Toy Jesus figure
- Red and green construction paper

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Place the red and green papers on the floor to define the "No" and "Yes" piles. Put all the items in the bag/box.

During the Activity: Let children take turns pulling one item out of the bag. Ask them, "Will this be in Heaven?" and help them decide. A bandage for boo-boos? No, there are no ouchies in Heaven (*place on red paper*). A happy face? Yes! We will always be happy in Heaven (*place on green paper*).

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Our Bible Story tells us some amazing things about Heaven. Let's look in our story bag and decide what will be in Heaven and what won't."

During the Activity: "[Child's name], pull something out of our story bag/box! (*Child pulls out a bandage.*) It's a bandage for a boo-boo. Will we have boo-boos in Heaven? (*Pause.*) No! In Heaven, we will never be hurt. So, we'll put this on the red paper for 'No'. [Next child's name], what did you find? (*Child pulls out a happy face.*) A happy face! Will we be happy in Heaven? (*Pause.*) Yes! We will be with Jesus, so we will be happy forever! Let's put this on the green paper for 'Yes.'" (*Continue with the items that will not be in Heaven: sad face drawing and thermometer. And the items that will be in Heaven: heart cutout, toy Jesus figure.*)

After the Activity: "Look! Heaven is a place with happy faces and love and Jesus! There will be no more sadness or boo-boos. Jesus is making Heaven a special place for us because **[Bottom Line] Jesus wants to be my friend forever.** Who wants to be your friend forever? **[Bottom Line] Jesus wants to be my friend forever.**"

What Do You Think?

What You Need:

- Butcher paper
- Washable markers, dot markers, metallic or glitter crayons
- Fun sparkly stickers
- Masking tape

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Tape the butcher paper to a table.

During the Activity: Tell the children the Bible says Heaven is a very special place. The most special place. Ask them what they think it looks like. Invite them to work together to draw their ideas of Heaven on the paper using the special, sparkly art supplies.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: “The Bible tells us, Heaven is the most special place ever. I wonder what it looks like. Let’s make a picture of what we think Heaven looks like together!”

During the Activity: “I have these super special, sparkly crayons and stickers for us. I found only the most special art supplies for us to use! What do you want to draw? (Let children share ideas.) A big house for Jesus? Let’s draw it! Streets of gold? Let’s draw it! Shiny things? Let’s add some stickers! Let’s make the most beautiful picture of Heaven we can imagine.”

After the Activity: “Wow! Our picture of Heaven is so beautiful and sparkly! It’s going to be the best place ever, because we will be with Jesus forever. Jesus is getting it all ready for us right now! Why? Because **[Bottom Line] Jesus wants to be my friend forever.** Who wants to be your friend forever? **[Bottom Line] Jesus wants to be my friend forever.**”
