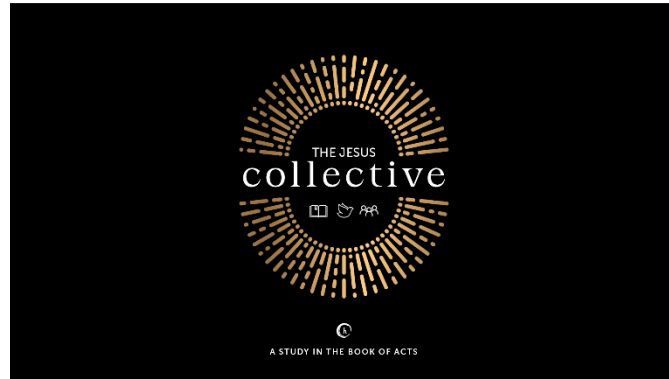

Community Group Questions: Acts 2:14-41

1. Tell how you became a Christian. (Specifically, when did you repent, confess your sins and get baptized?)
2. Did the “good news” of the gospel sound like “good news” to you? Why or why not?
3. How were you taught to explain “the gospel?” Is it similar or different from Peter’s message in Acts 2: “You killed Jesus. God raised Jesus. Jesus reigns.”
4. When you hear the phrase “the Day of the Lord,” does it sound like good news or bad news to you? Why do you think so?
5. Do you think people understand how God plans to conquer all evil on the “Day of the Lord?” (personal evil-individual sins, natural evil-sickness, plagues, disasters and deterioration, systemic evil-injustice, poverty, oppression, tyranny, etc.)
6. Do you think people understand that God plans to make everything new and perfect like it was in the Garden of Eden? Why or why not? How would this change their faith if they understood it?
7. How do you handle confession and repentance as ongoing personal practices today?
8. Have you ever been part of a group who practice confession and repentance with each other regularly? How did that impact you?
