Give yourself a moment to feel the weight of your sorrow.

Sit a moment and allow the Holy Spirit to show you your own heart and where it has deceived you. Take time now to confess your sins.

I know you are kind. I know you want the very best for me, in all things. I know I am one who chooses sin. I have deceived myself. The truth, your truth is not functioning in me correctly. I desire truth in my inmost being.

Allow yourself to see the truth.

Forgive me for my sins. Restore the joy of salvation to me. . Search me and know me. Show me where my heart has been deceived, I want to be free from my hidden sins. Please don't leave me alone with myself. Jesus, would you sit with me now in silence.

Allow a moment of silence to sit with Jesus.

Jesus, would you allow your forgiveness to be felt deep within my bones. Remind me of your great love for me today, now, in this moment and as you work with me to remove these deeply engrained patterns of sin from within me. I desire a new heart, recreated from flesh not the cold stone it feels like today.

Be aware of how you feel in this moment. Be very conscious of how your body responds as you receive forgiveness.

I want to become more like Jesus, allow my trust in your continual work in me to be strong. I look for what you are doing and the way you are working in me. Thank you for loving me through this time and not leaving me. May my life bring you glory, amen.
