Community Group Questions: John 6:25-36

- In Mark 6:3, if Jesus was a builder, how do you think he viewed the technology of his day? (either as a skilled carpenter or stone worker)
- How do you think he would view the digital technology of our day? (tools, instruments and devices) Why do you think so?
- In Luke 9:33, why do you think Peter felt compelled to start building a tabernacle when Jesus was transfigured? How does that compare with the way Christians today use technology for worship and evangelism?
- In John 6:25-34, it seems like Jesus is calling out the people for just wanting him to give them food (v27), rules (v28) and miracles (v30). Do you think we treat Jesus the same way? Why or why not?
- In John 6:35, Jesus finally resists the crowd's plea to give them something. Instead, he said something like "all I have to give you is my life." Do you think we treat Jesus like a tool or an instrument to help us get what we want? Why do you think that?
- How do you think "consumerism" affects our relationship with Jesus? What can we do to change that?
- How do you handle your boredom? Is there something you need to do differently?
