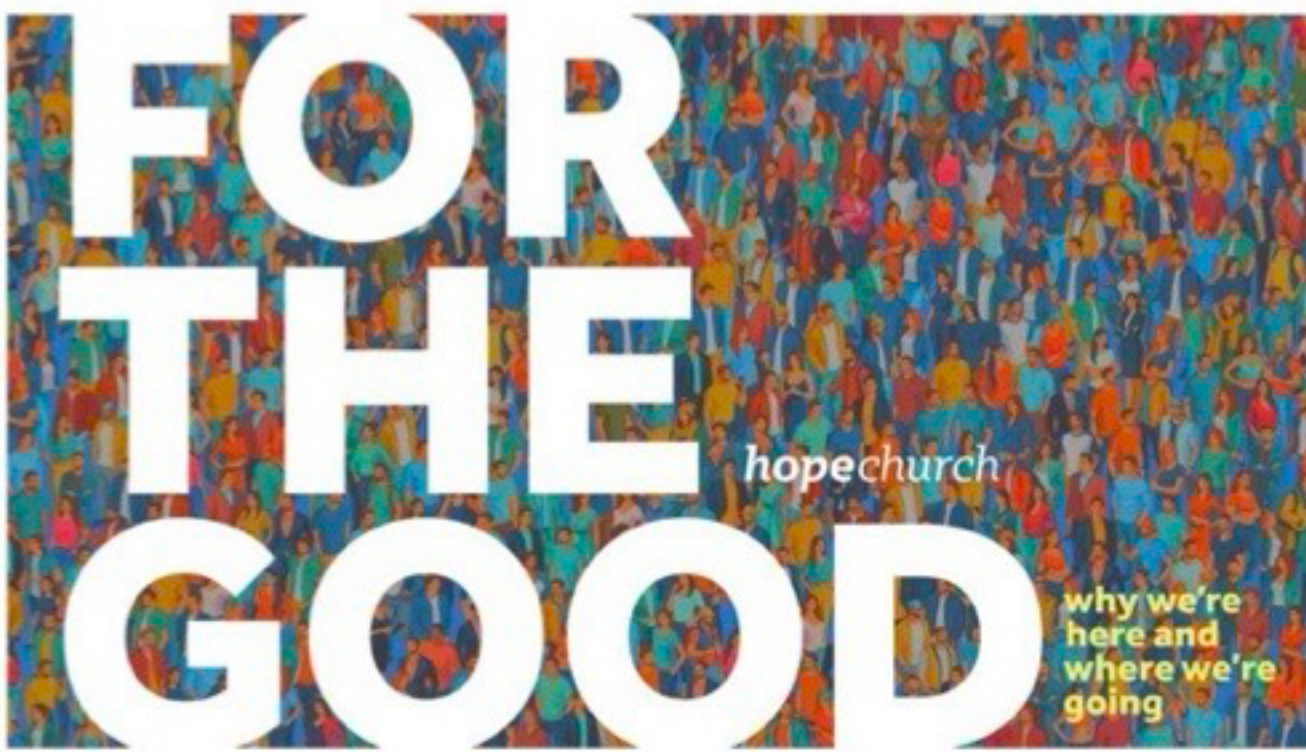




Sermon Discussion Questions July 26, 2026: For All Generations

One Aware Question: How have you seen God at work recently in you as you pray for your One?

Read Ephesians 3:10-21

1. Share about your concepts of God when you were a kid. What did He look like in your child-like mind? Was there anyone that had a major influence on your faith in that season?
2. How is God choosing to reveal his wisdom? (v. 10-13) And to whom? Why?
3. Paul tells the Ephesians not to be discouraged because of his sufferings in this context. How do his sufferings relate to what he has just said in verses 10-12?
4. How do you see yourself, our culture, those around you-approaching suffering? Why do you think this is the case? Is it different than Paul's approach?
5. Verses 14-19 are a prayer Paul is praying for his spiritual family in Ephesus. What does he want for them? What is this power going to allow them to grasp?
6. Note the number and variety of adjectives Paul uses to describe the love of Christ. Share a way that you are living like you believe this. Share a way that you are living that shows you don't believe this.
7. Verse 20 reminds us that His power is at work within us. Where do you need Him and His power to show up in you this week? Spend some time praying about these issues together.
