Week 2 — Mighty God & Peace

Isaiah 9:6 Discussion Questions

1. When you hear the word “mighty,” what’s the first image you think of — a soldier, a superhero, someone in your own life? What shaped that idea of might?
2. Where do people usually look for protection or security today (money, government, knowledge, personal strength)? How much peace do those really provide? When do people most often begin looking for protection? Which of those “whens” is truest for you?
3. Isaiah spoke these words to people facing a brutal empire. How do you think they would have reacted to the promise of “Mighty God”? What peace would they have been desperate for?
4. God’s answer to war was a child, not a stronger army. What does that reveal about God’s strategy for bringing peace?
5. What is the difference between peace that comes from the absence of conflict and peace that comes from the presence of God?
6. Our world’s darkness often shows up through constant news, fear, and information overload. What are the “Assyrians” that threaten your peace right now?
7. When have you experienced God giving peace before He gave answers? How did that steady your heart?
8. Who is someone in your life that could use your prayers for peace? Close your time together praying a prayer of blessing and peace over those in your life who are needing God’s peace.
