

## **March 26 Group Discussion**

### 1 LIFE engagement question

ONE aim: To see God at work in the relationships He has placed around us and join Him in His work. Praying for others in this and sharing stories builds our faith and gives us courage. Be patient and extend grace to one another as each one of you devotes yourselves to following Jesus' lead in your relationships. Everyone does not need to share each time you meet. Let God lead and do the work. What have you found surprising as you have been blessing and investing in your ONE?

### **Read John 11:1-44.**

Discussion Questions: Jesus delays going to Lazarus even though He loves him. Have you ever experienced a situation where it felt like God was slow to act or didn't show up when you expected? What was that like for you?

Martha tells Jesus, "If you had been here, my brother would not have died." Have you ever had a moment where you felt disappointed with God, even if you didn't say it out loud? What did you do with that feeling?

Jesus knew He was about to raise Lazarus, and still, He wept. What does that tell you about how God responds to your grief or pain?

Before the miracle, Jesus asks for the stone to be moved. Where in your life might God be asking you to take a step of trust before you see the outcome?

Lazarus comes out still wrapped in grave clothes, and others are told to help remove them. What might this suggest about the role of community in healing and restoration?

Where in your life right now feels lifeless, stuck, or beyond hope? What would it look like to trust Jesus with that area, even if nothing has changed yet?
