Community Group Questions: Luke 15:8-10

1. How do you react to the phrase “lost people?” Why does it feel that way to you?
2. Describe a time when you got “lost in the shuffle” or fell in the cracks.
3. What did you think about others? What did you feel about your situation? What did you do about it?
4. What makes it difficult for us to accept someone’s effort to reach out when we’re in that position?
5. Why does it feel difficult to know how to reach out?
6. Looking around our city, do you notice any areas that seem to have been “lost in the shuffle?”
7. What groups of people are often “left behind” in our society? Without getting into lots of history or blame, what is it about our world that always leaves someone behind?
8. Consider for sake of discussion that the point of this story is not about how people get left behind but about how they get found...and how we celebrate when they are found. Where do you see good examples of our society “searching carefully” for “lost coins?”
9. How do we place value on people differently than God does?
